COM Interface

- ▶ *SetMultipleAttributes*: Columns with empty attribute IDs are now ignored. In this way, a matrix created by a call to *GetMultipleAttributes* can be reused for the *Set...* function even if not-editable attributes are contained. (1667)

Dialogs

- ▶ *Graphic parameters dialog box, classification*: Entering an invalid class limit like "<" or "=" (thus without a number) does not cause a crash anymore. (5368)

Timetable Editor

- ▶ *Creating regular services*: The program will not crash if the assignment result is discarded by this operation. (6447)

I/O

- ▶ *Reading blocks from network file*: The "end time" of a block is no longer reset to 0 when additively reading block items from a network file in mode "overwrite course". (6474)
- ▶ *Reading a network file*: The "overwrite" mode did not work for connectors. In the past "overwrite attributes" was used instead. The error has been fixed. (6470)

Junction Editor

- ▶ *SCJ optimization*: During green-time optimization of stage-based signal controllers, lane volumes are in all cases determined precisely for the decisive saturation per stage now. (6482)

Listings

- ▶ *Copy & paste*: Alternative to Ctrl+C and Ctrl+V you can now also activate copy & paste via the keyboard shortcuts Ctrl+Insert and Shift+Insert. (6118)
- ▶ *Context-sensitive menu in listings*: The context-sensitive menu is now also available if all rows of the listing are marked. (6378)
- ▶ *Synchronization listings <-> network editor*: No more problems with the evaluation of the current network editor marking if a listing of the same type is currently open. (6488)
- ▶ *Copy & paste*: Data of any desired cell range can now be exchanged with Excel via the clipboard. (6390)

Network Editor

- ▶ *Quick view*: Individual cells can now also be copied and pasted in the quick view window - entirely analogous to listings. (6232)
- ▶ *Quick view*: Several cells can now also be marked and e.g. be edited simultaneously in the quick view window. (6443)

Object Model

- ▶ *Vehicle journey items*: Objects of this type are now 'active' if
 - a) they meet the filter condition (as before), and
 - b) their vehicle journey is "in selection" (new).
 The second condition is needed to create specific sets of active objects, e.g. via COM, (6481)

Other Operations

- ▶ *Modal Split (Standardized assessment)*: Procedure parameters (e.g. G1 and G2) are correctly saved to protocol file now. (6483)
- ▶ *Flow bundle*: When a GPA file is read selectively, a flow bundle will only be recomputed if flow bundle parameters were actually imported. (6471)
- ▶ *Coordinate transformations*: Computational errors in the transformation have been fixed. (6478)

PuT Assignment

- ▶ *Headway-based assignment*: If the headways are calculated from the timetable, vehicle journeys with a departure time beyond 24:00 used to be ignored. This error has been fixed. (6486)
- ▶ *Skim matrix calculation*: If the demand segment selected for skims is deleted from the network, the assignment parameters are adapted such that the first remaining demand segment takes its place. Thus it can no longer happen that skim matrices with an empty demand segment reference

are created. (6487)

Dialogs

- ▶ *Generate EVA sequence of operations:* The assistant provides the following new functionalities:
 1. Optional Go To operation,
 2. Selection of the DSegs the indicators of which are to be averaged via MSA in the iteration,
 3. Selection of the DSeg to check convergence during Go To operation. (6454)
- ▶ *Dialog Create vehicle journey(s):* Only line routes with a time profile can be selected in this dialog. (5736)
- ▶ *Node dialog box:* Node topologies are now always correctly adjusted when editing the main node number. (6436)

Filters

- ▶ *Mode "undirected":* In the filter dialog for links and connectors, the button which activates mode "undirected" is now visible again. (6456)

Graphics

- ▶ *Reading a GPA file:* The program does not produce an error anymore when ignoring the graphic parameters for the print page. (6468)
- ▶ *DXF export:* The export is no longer cancelled due to memory shortage. (6433)

I/O

- ▶ *Editing project directories:* The directory for projections is no longer changed when clicking "All" in dialog Edit project directories -just like in case of PFD files and User VDF DLLs. In contrast to other file types, projections do not differ in the event of different projects; an adjustment of the path is thus not desired. (6457)
- ▶ *Read ATT file:* Attribute files can now also be read in for Tsys and modes. (6437)
- ▶ *Writing an EDF file:* VISUM no longer crashes if the export is cancelled with a click on "Cancel". (6435)

Listings

- ▶ *Paste attributes from clipboard:* In the following cases, VISUM no longer crashes when importing input attributes with subattributes:
 1. in case of connector attribute Weight (PrT or PuT),
 2. if the subattribute is not contained in the target network anymore, e.g. due to a missing Tsys. (6446)
- ▶ Keyboard shortcuts which start scripts from the script menu now also work if the active window is a listing. (6407)

Demand Model

- ▶ *EVA Weighting:* The weighting functions EVA1, EVA2 and Schiller were adjusted to the parameterization described in the manual. (6455)

Network Editor

- ▶ Keyboard shortcut "Ctrl-G", which calls up the Gpar dialog box, now also works if the floating dialog of line route is activated. (6217)
- ▶ *Deleting coupled time profiles:* VISUM no longer crashes when deleting couplings if time profiles are deleted in the process. (6438)

Interfaces

- ▶ *Subnetwork generator:* The operation is no longer cancelled with error message "Network does not contain link from node x to node y". This could occur if the first section of the path to be exported lay within a main node. (6469)
- ▶ *Subnetwork generator:* Main nodes are now only exported if they contain at least one node to be exported. (6467)

Other Operations

- ▶ *Operation "Edit attribute":* The program does not crash anymore if the operation is run for user-defined attributes which are no longer contained in the network. (6445)

Miscellaneous

- ▶ Rounding numbers with decimal places no longer leads to an instable performance. The effect could occur anywhere in the program, yet was computer-dependent. (6448)

Attributes

- ▶ The turn attributes FromPrio and ToPrio were sometimes miscalculated in the past if the links that were used to determine these attributes were one-ways roads. The error has been fixed. (6398)

COM Interface

- ▶ A new method called "ExistsByKey" is available at *IConnectors*, which is used to verify the existence of a connector between a pair zone-node. (5720)
- ▶ A new method called "ItemByID" is available at *ILineRoutes* and *ITimeProfiles*, which is used to get an object via its numeric ID. (6417)
- ▶ The decimal separator (full stop or comma) can now be read and set via COM. This is done at *IOptions* with method *DecimalSeparator*. (6412)

Dialogs

- ▶ Buttons which transfer changes to the network that were made in a dialog but do not close the dialog are now called "Preview" throughout the program, even if option "Cancel" is provided after the operation. If the dialog remains open, they are called "Apply". (5947)
- ▶ *Dialog box Log and Error files*: 1. The time of the last modification is no longer (two hours) too old, 2. The time is now issued in the common format hh:mm. (6393)

I/O

- ▶ *Reading major flows from version files*: Manually set major flows are no longer ignored when reading version files saved with VISUM 9.5 or older versions, if the involved links are one-ways roads. (6421)
- ▶ *Reading a network file*: If line routes without a valid course are discarded at the end of the import, VISUM now records the names of the respective objects in the error file Error.txt. (6411)
- ▶ *Network I/O, "Frequent cases"*: In scenario "Timetable", VISUM now uses the correct settings for tables line route item and time profile item. (6414)
- ▶ *Write network file, table Lanes*: Attribute *OriginLaneNo.* is allocated with the same logic as in VISUM <= 9.5: it refers to the next through lane. (6424)
- ▶ *HAFAS import*: If, due to a coupling, vehicle journeys need to be deleted because they start or end in the coupled section, VISUM now asks the user whether the objects should really be deleted. If denied, the vehicle journeys are retained and no coupling is created. The vehicle journeys concerned are listed in the trace file. (6426)

Listings

- ▶ *Entering cell values*: Pasting an empty string from the clipboard no longer leads to a crash. (6428)
- ▶ (Sporadic) crashes no longer occur when clicking menu entry "Listings" following repeated imports of a version file. (6429)
- ▶ *Layout files for POI listings*: List layout files of different POI categories are now interchangeable. (3965)
- ▶ *Analysis rows*: The display of analysis rows in a list no longer leads to a crash when in the difference network mode. (6434)
- ▶ *Tooltips*: Listings display column header tooltips again with the attribute ID of the column. (6364)
- ▶ *Context-sensitive menu*: Values of enumerated types (e.g. control type of a node) can now be selected directly in the context-sensitive menu of the list again. (6339)
- ▶ *Marking a column*: Marking an entire column in a path listing no longer leads to a crash due to lack of memory. (6409)

Matrix Editor

- ▶ *MLG file*: Operation "Set value" in the context-sensitive menu (right mouse button) can now be executed from within an MLG file. (5604)

Network Editor

- ▶ If you dock both window Quick view and window Network objects when they were previously

hidden or closed, VISUM now automatically restores the most recently used vertical division between the two windows. (6158)

- ▶ If you close window Quick view and window Network objects, VISUM now restores this status when exiting and reopening the program. (6218)
- ▶ *Check network*: Main turns are now also taken into account when checking for useless turns. (6366)
- ▶ *Deleting stops*: VISUM no longer crashes when deleting a stop at which a vehicle journey or a vehicle journey section ends which does not run until the end of its line route. (6383)
- ▶ *You can now use entry "Block" of the context-sensitive menu to block turns and main turns for all TSys (main turns: just in the context-sensitive menu of listings). So far the command was provided for turns only (former entry: "Delete").* (6392)
- ▶ *Blocking links*: A detailed warning is now issued if a link cannot be blocked for a TSys since the link is traversed by system routes of the respective TSys. (6423)

Object Model

- ▶ *Major flows*: Major flows are no longer defined between two exit links or between two entry links. (6321)

Other Operations

- ▶ *PuT shortest path search*: Repeated calculations of the operation are now notably faster if the search graph is internally build up anew only in the case of actual modifications to the network. (6198)

PrT Assignment

- ▶ *Equilibrium_Lohse*: The PrT assignment variant produces correct path volumes again. These were incorrect as of service pack 10.00-12 and did thus not match the (correct) link volumes in the network. (6395)

Attributes

- ▶ For parameter d of the Akcelik2 function, the lower limit of the value range has been changed to 0.01. (4824)
- ▶ New zone attributes provide direct access to row and column totals, minima etc. of OD matrices and skim matrices. (6079)

COM Interface

- ▶ *Export of the timetable editor*: In the auxiliary attribute "NO" of the vehicle journeys, the line route item index is now returned. (6397)
- ▶ *PrT shortest path search*: The path found so far is no longer initialised before running a new search via COM if the script does not explicitly contain an equivalent command. This way, an existing path can now also be extended in the PrT shortest path search. (6323)
- ▶ *Procedure parameters*: For access to SingleSkimMatrixPara, capitalization or use of small letters respectively is no longer regarded for indicator IDs. In case of an invalid ID a COM-Error will be returned. (6348)

Dialogs

- ▶ *Dialog box "Print area"*: The input field entries for width and height in [mm] are displayed in red again if the values exceed the output value of the print page. (6325)
- ▶ *Save network*: The context-sensitive menu of a table (right-click) now provides functionalities to simultaneously switch on/off all attributes of a table. (5986)
- ▶ *Filter dialog window*: Can now be resized. (4526)

Graphics

- ▶ *Screenshot*: The screenshot functionality is now available in the graphical timetable and in the timetable network graph. (5165)
- ▶ *Legend*: In the legend, line bars are displayed for active lines only (similar to network display). (6329)
- ▶ *Large background images*: Backgrounds from an image size of 5000 x 5000 pixels are now displayed correctly again when zooming into the network. (6330)
- ▶ *Background texts*: Any Unicode character can now be displayed. (6369)

- ▶ *Scaling backgrounds*: The scaling of backgrounds using button "Scale" works correctly again. (6381)
- ▶ *Drawing polygons*: Drawing polygons with enclaves no longer leads to insufficient memory. (6379)

I/O

- ▶ *Printing*: The program no longer crashes if no printer is installed when negating the subsequently issued prompt for a printer to be installed. (6359)
- ▶ *Read/save network*: When reading a network additively or saving a network selectively, a dialog now lists frequently occurring use cases which can be applied instead of assorting the concerned tables by hand. (1437)
- ▶ *Saving an OD matrix*: Flag "Consider OD pair filter" now also takes effect if the matrix is saved in binary format. (1441)
- ▶ *HAFAS import*: The import now takes into account that some of the project files might have been changed since the last import. (6127)
- ▶ *PAR file import*: You can now also read in either just the procedures ("Operations") or just the functions of the procedure parameters. (6260)

Listings

- ▶ *Printing listings*: Listings can be printed again directly from VISUM. (6334)
- ▶ *Column width*: 1) Double-click the column separator for optimum column width. 2) Similar to Excel, multiple marked columns can be set to uniform column width by dragging. (6240)
- ▶ *Default settings for listings*: In the new tab "Listings" in the "Options" dialog window, you may tick an option for network synchronization and select the font for listings and quick view display. (6049)
- ▶ *Spatial selection*: Listings are now automatically updated when modifying the spatial selection. (6374)
- ▶ *PuT path listings*: The display and export of PuT path listings has been accelerated. (6362)
- ▶ *Listing Stops - Stop transition times*: The new listing provides more convenient editing of the walk times between the stop areas of a stop. (5577)
- ▶ *Fix column*: This context menu command has been made available again. (6336)
- ▶ Now, invalid entries cause editing mode termination. (6338)
- ▶ *Save layout*: Saving a layout file from the list of vehicle journeys will no longer cause a program crash. (6345)
- ▶ *Path listings*: Both listing PrT path on link level and listing PuT path legs can now be saved in a format suitable for data base exports, either with or without a "header" for each path. (5106)

PuT Operating Indicators

- ▶ *Revenue calculation*: If option "Fix revenue per PTripUnlinked" or option "Revenue per fare point" is selected, the setting now also takes effect if fares were not calculated in the assignment but read from file. (6115)

Matrix Editor

- ▶ *Reading \$O matrices*: When opening matrices in format \$O within the matrix editor, values are no longer assigned to the wrong OD pairs. (6396)
- ▶ A section of matrix cells, rows, or columns can correctly be selected with the "Shift" key again. (6403)
- ▶ *Undo functionality*: The following operations can now also be undone: 1. Copy & paste of matrix cells. 2. Edit individual matrix cells. (6386)

Network Editor

- ▶ *Insert line route*: The "Edit" dialog is now automatically displayed after the completion of the route course of a newly inserted line route. (6306)
- ▶ *Quick view*: When exiting a field marked with a * (symbolising deviating attribute values), the program no longer issues a warning saying that the value cannot be saved. (5566)
- ▶ *Split link*: A crash no longer occurs if a user has write access to a link but only read access to the speed limits on that link. (6148)
- ▶ *Copy system route*: The newly created system route is now immediately displayed in the system route dialog. (6385)
- ▶ *Only active objects can be clicked*: This setting now also takes effect during complex Insert and Edit operations like editing the shape of line routes or inserting a connector, and not just when directly clicking on objects. (6259)

- ▶ *Lane definition*: Even in the case of faulty geometric data (from VISUM 8), resetting the lane definitions no longer causes a crash. (6331)
- ▶ *Quick view*: Changing the default font for list output does now also take effect for quick view display. (6355)
- ▶ *Quick view*: One common quick view layout file is now saved for all network object types. (6298)
- ▶ *Copy line route*: The newly created line route is now always marked. (6343)
- ▶ *Difference network*: Background polygons and background texts can be edited and deleted in the difference network mode again. (6324)
- ▶ *Context-sensitive menu of system routes*: The Multi-Edit functionality works again. (6404)
- ▶ *Edit shape of line route*: The line route dialog is not displayed anymore while editing the shape of a line route. (6263)

Object Model

- ▶ *Shortest path search*: The same shortest path algorithm as in VISUM 9.5 is now applied to PrT isochrones and when completing or inserting line routes. Memory shortage problems thus no longer arise. (6280)

Interfaces

- ▶ *Delimiter*: The decimal separator which used to be a network property has to be set globally under "Options" now. (6335)
- ▶ *HAFAS import*: Cancelling the import in the initial phase does not cause a crash anymore. (6357)

Other Operations

- ▶ *PuT shortest path search*: A click on "Initialize" now also clears the PuT shortest path search listing. (6315)
- ▶ *Read survey data*: When reading in multi-line survey data, the name of the line is now also correctly identified if no transport system is specified. (6328)

Miscellaneous

- ▶ *Menu Help*: The menu contains new entries that provide access to the VISUM documentation and the support form. (6190)

PrT & PuT Assignment

- ▶ *All path listings*: New relations to origin and destination connectors permit the display of connector-based data. (6296)

PuT Assignment

- ▶ *Read PuT assignment data from version file*: Path volumes are no longer multiplied by factor 10^n when a version file is opened which was saved with VISUM 10 after reading data from an older version file which has been created with a VISUM version before version 10. (Here, n = number of decimal places for assignment calculation.) (6356)
- ▶ *PuT assignment statistics*: VISUM used to allocate unrealistic, way too low values to factor "PTripsUnlinked" which is issued in the zone and total statistics. (2038)
- ▶ *Path volumes*: The rounding of path volumes did not work reliably stable in arithmetical respect in case of a defined number of decimal places for demand values and volumes, e.g. first volumes of path A were rounded up and then the volumes of path B. This bug could be fixed. (6360)

TFlowFuzzy

- ▶ *Main turns*: TFlowFuzzy now also handles main nodes correctly, i.e. counted data are taken into account at main turns yet not at inner links of main nodes. (6346)
- ▶ Correct PrT flow matrix calculation even in case of paths via main nodes. (6347)

COM Interface

- ▶ *Analysis time intervals*: The method AnalysisTimes.TimeInterval does not return an error anymore when accessing the last time interval. (6317)
- ▶ *Exporting a listing*: The utilised key fields can now be set both via COM and interactively in the dialog. (5554)

Dialogs

- ▶ *Dialog box Stops*: The first column of the Walk times tab is now always wide enough to fully display the numbers of the stop areas. **(6284)**
- ▶ *Network I/O, frequent cases*: When selecting use case Timetable, the program now also activates tables "Vehicle journey sections" and "specific walk and wait times". **(6242)**
- ▶ Dialog box "Procedure parameters": VISUM now automatically adjusts the jump address of "Go to the operation" procedures when creating or shifting a "Group" procedure. **(6128)**

Timetable Editor

- ▶ *Edit shape of line route*: Editing the shape of line routes sometimes led to a crash if the timetable editor was open at the same time. The error has been fixed. **(6318)**

Graphics

- ▶ *Legend*: If a POI category is deleted and a new one created instead, the legend now displays its correct name and no longer the name of the deleted category. **(6314)**
- ▶ The global marking color ("Basis" tab) can now be used for all types at the touch of a button. **(2882)**
- ▶ *Drawing main turns*: Main turns can now be graphically displayed in the same manner as turns. Both types together form a layer. **(4466)**

I/O

- ▶ *PDF files*: The file extensions of third party file formats (like image files, shape files, access databases,...) can no longer be edited. This modification became necessary since in the past, due to accidental modifications or the import of out-dated project directory files, some of the file formats processed in VISUM were not displayed. **(6302)**
- ▶ *Difference network*: The use of version files with activated PrT shortest path search does not lead to a crash anymore. **(6322)**

Listings

- ▶ *Default layout*: When opening a listing for the first time, several important attributes with subattributes (like volume (AP)) are displayed automatically again. **(6299)**
- ▶ *OD pairs listing*: This new listing provides direct access to OD and skim matrix values, which can be edited like the values of all new listings. **(5520)**
- ▶ In the new listings also, functionality "Undir. value" now operates correctly. **(6273)**
- ▶ *Difference network*: The case that all cells of the new listings are empty in mode Difference network does not occur anymore. **(6312)**
- ▶ *PuT path legs*: Saving the list to a file or the clipboard no longer leads to errors caused by lack of memory. **(6293)**

PuT Operating Indicators

- ▶ *PuT Operating Indicators*: The procedure no longer generates PuT territory detail objects of which all attributes amount to 0. **(6245)**
- ▶ Line costing results are no longer discarded immediately if the user modifies option "Calculate indicators for..." on tab LineCosting or option "Use for calculated results" on tab Analysis time intervals. This will only take effect during the next execution of the procedure. **(5953)**

Network Editor

- ▶ *Insert POI*: If no POI category exists when inserting the POI, the program now returns to the dialog box that is used to insert POI categories. **(5839)**
- ▶ *Main lines*: The context-sensitive menu of lines now also provides access to options Multi-Edit (including operation Intersect) and Multi-Delete for main lines and to the corresponding listing. **(6241)**
- ▶ *Dialog box Line routes*:
 1. Extending the marking via the Ctrl key no longer causes the dialog to scroll to the beginning of the marking.
 2. The columns are now adjusted automatically when modifying the size of the dialog. **(6262)**
- ▶ *Background texts*: VISUM no longer crashes when deleting multiple texts if a text is marked at the same time. **(6265)**
- ▶ *Aggregate nodes*: The operation no longer produces invalid line route courses. **(6276)**
- ▶ *Zoom by factor*: The specified factor is now interpreted as customary: in case of entries > 1, VISUM zooms in, in case of entries < 1, VISUM zooms out. **(6304)**

- ▶ *Edit shape of line route*: Clicking "Refresh" or shifting the display detail no longer results in a redraw of the the line route course that was valid before rerouting the course. (6274)

Other Operations

- ▶ *LineBlocking*: The program no longer generates unnecessary layover block items with a time period of zero in networks with service trips that have a starting time past midnight. (6301)
- ▶ *Edit attribute*: The operation can now also be utilised to allocate string-valued attributes. (5834)
- ▶ *Flow bundle*: The calculation of flow bundles no longer leads to an infinite loop if an OD pair filter is activated at the same time. (6310)

PrT Assignment

- ▶ PrT assignments "Tribut" and "DUE": Both assignments now also work with connector shares ("MPA"). (6247)
- ▶ *Connector weights per relation*: Different PrT assignments possibly save multiple volumes per path (e.g. in case of several DSeg for one TSys or when saving by time interval). In combination with connector weights these differentiated path volumes were aggregated incorrectly on zone level so far. The error has been fixed. (6300)
- ▶ *Traffix*: VISUM no longer crashes if the name of the utilised network file exceeds thirty characters. (6303)
- ▶ *TModel volume-delay functions*: The upper limit of the value range for the parameters a and a' has been raised to 1000. (6305)

COM Interface

- ▶ Matrices can now also be created, deleted, and assigned to Dsegs via COM. (1430)
- ▶ *Muuli*: The Muuli COM interface can now also be called directly from the VISUM COM interface via Visum.Matrixeditor. A separate registration is thus no longer necessary. (6164)

Dialogs

- ▶ *Dialog "Log and Error files"*: The dialog only displays log and error files that were produced by VISUM itself. (6244)
- ▶ *Dialog box "Procedure parameters"*: Double-click on a procedure of type "Group" in order to expand/reduce the respective group. So far this could only be achieved by double-clicking the row header. (6204)
- ▶ *Dialog box "Procedure parameters", tab Blocking-back model*: Activating the blocking-back model no longer produces a deadlock if input parameters on this tab fall outside of the valid range. (6235)

Timetable Editor

- ▶ *Shorten vehicle journeys*: The arrival and departure times of modified vehicle journey items were sometimes displayed incorrectly when shortening vehicle journeys in the timetable editor. The error has been fixed. (6227)

Graphics

- ▶ *Point object symbols*: The following new icons are now available as symbols: Stop sign, Two-way stop (TWS), Signal controlled (SCJ), and five-pointed star (POI). (5961)
- ▶ *Legend*: Stop catchment areas and the colour gradient of the 2D display (usually for isochrones) are now also displayed in the legend. (4314)
- ▶ *Drawing polygons with enclaves*: Such polygons can now also be drawn if users greatly zoom in. (6248)
- ▶ *Edit shape*: VISUM now automatically initiates a refresh of the network when editing the shape of line routes in order to e.g. update link labels with attribute "Number lines". (6253)

I/O

- ▶ *Read network*: Signal groups with a green time start or end that exceeds the cycle time of the signal group are now rejected with a corresponding warning. (6251)
- ▶ Import transactions like Read network and Read attributes are as fast as in VISUM 9.5 again. (6212)
