• New Features and Changes

Dialogs

- License confirmation for OpenStreetMap background maps: The knowledge of the license terms for OpenStreetMap background maps have to be confirmed less often than before (only once per Visum session). (13270)
- Preview of the background map in the graphic parameters dialog: The preview of the background map in the graphic parameters dialog now runs in the background. You can thus specify settings in the dialog before the preview is refreshed. (12690)

Filters

Complement in filter dialog: For all group filters (OD pairs of zones, PrT paths, stops, lines), you can now display and edit the state of the complement option on the level of the overall filter condition for a network object type. So far, this option only existed in the data model (and thus via COM or in the XLM filter file). The effect is the same. (11883)

Junction editor

• Vissim node preview: The preview has been updated to version PTV Vissim 7. (14035)

Listings

List 'Fare systems': A new list for fare systems has been added. You can edit the values of user-defined attributes of fare systems in this list. For technical reasons, this list is not restored when saving a version file in Visum 14. (14202)

Miscellaneous

User setting 'Load map services automatically when opening version files and graphic parameter files': This setting in the user preferences used to affect static background maps only. It has now been renamed 'Permit loading of background maps from the internet'. If this option is not active, neither live background maps nor static background maps are displayed in the network editor. In the graphic parameters dialog, no preview will then be available on the page 'Background map'. Any internet access to background maps will be switched off. (13815)

PuT Passenger Survey

Acceleration of plausibilization and direct assignment: The 'Plausibilization of survey data' procedure is now up to 15% faster and the 'Direct assignment' procedure up to 90% faster. In rare cases (where there are multiple line routes of the same line which have vehicle journeys matching the input data, i.e. such which run at the same time between the same stops), results may change once. (14210)

Timetable Editor

- Exporting the tabular timetable to the clipboard: You can now export the entire tabular timetable to the clipboard (again). **(14102)**
- Single-row and double-row display in the tabular timetable: Even if some marked stops are not displayed in two rows, in the context menu of the tabular timetable, you can now switch to a single-row display of marked stops and vice versa. (14175)
- Sorting in the tabular timetable: So far, when editing the departure time of a displayed vehicle journey, Visum used to re-sort the display in the tabular timetable according to the standard sequence, thus destroying an existing sorting. This error has been fixed. A reorganization (and thus sorting) of the display cannot be avoided when inserting or deleting vehicle journeys. (14166)

GROUP

Add-Ins

- Import Google Transit Feed: So far, reading in ANSI-coded files with the 'Import Google Transit Feed' add-in failed. This error has been fixed. (14179)
- VisumPy.helpers: The functions GetMatrix and GetODMatrix from the VisumPy library now deliver the same return values as in the versions of the library delivered with Visum 13. (14204)

Data Model

- Moving vehicle journeys to a different time: In the past, the departure of a vehicle journey could be > 48:00:00 based on different approaches, for example when moving vehicle journeys to a different time in the tabular or graphical timetable. This error has been fixed. (14201)
- Transport system of lines: So far, it was basically possible to allocate a transport system of the type PrT or PuT-Walk to a line; it was only prevented in the dialog. The error has been fixed. (14170)

Dialogs

- 'HAFAS import' dialog: You can copy and paste on the 'Transport systems' page of the HAFAS import parameters dialog. Pasted values were not saved, however, but only displayed in the dialog. This error has been fixed. (14169)
- Classification in graphic parameter dialogs: The display of the cells is now refreshed correctly when entering or inserting copied colors on page 'Active OD pairs > Display' of the graphic parameters dialog of the matrix editor, in all classification grids of the graphic parameters dialog of the tabular timetable, and on page 'Header data > Background' of the line block editor. (13999)
- Shifting vehicle journeys: If you the shifted vehicle journeys of the selected time profile using the icon 'Change times of the current time profile's vehicle journeys' in the 'Items and time profiles' tab of the 'Edit line route' dialog, some vehicle journeys were not shifted sometimes. This error has been fixed. (14183)

Foreign Formats

'PuT supply from Visum' import: If an ID search was switched on and the option 'Only use ID references for existing stop points, do not perform geographical search' was selected, the program did not search geographically if no existing stop point could be found as candidate. In addition, the program handled cases incorrectly where the same stop point in the target network was found as candidate for two successive line route items. Both errors have been fixed.

Candidates found in a geographical search while option 'Only use ID references for existing stop points, do not perform geographical search' has been selected and not via ID references will be issued in a warning. (14141)

Key overflow during import of 'PuT supply from Visum': The PuT supply from Visum import no longer crashes if an overflow occurs for an object with a numerical key in the target network (number is higher than approx. 2.1 billon). This happens if the number in the source network plus the set offset is higher than the maximum permissable value. The import still does not work in this case. You have to use the conflict avoidance option 'Compress with offset' for an import. (14039)

Graphical Procedures

- Filters and shortest path search: So far, the active filters were evaluated anew with each change to a shortest path search (for example the selection of the origin or destination zone or of an intermediate node), because saving the route index to any attibute can affect each filter condition. This evaluation of the filters is now only carried out if the route index is actually saved. (14222)
- Shift network and flow bundle: In the 'Flow bundle' mode, you could not switch to the 'Shift network' mode by means of the space bar but only by means of the middle mouse button or the toolbar icon. This error has been fixed. (14207)

Graphics

Zooming background maps: Zooming out far (map of the earth visible several times) while the background map was switched on resulted in poor visual effects. This error has been fixed. (13868)

Line blocking

Negative minimum layover times and circle lines: When creating open blocks and activating option 'Always permit the transition between the sections of a vehicle journey' while negative minimum layover times (i.e. limited timetable changes) are permitted during line blocking and the vehicle journeys to be planned contain vehicle journeys on ring lines, entirely inefficient blocks are generated, which contain only one vehicle journey each on the ring line. This error has been fixed. (14196)

Main Window

Empty windows in case of missing licenses: If you read in a version file which contained windows to be restored for which no current license existed (e.g. schematic line diagram, transfers display of regular services, signal time-space diagram), empty window were displayed when activating the options 'Apply from version file, otherwise retain' or 'Apply from version file, otherwise reset' for the window configuration. This error has been fixed. (13664)

Miscellaneous

Memory consumption in networks with a lot of time series items: Visum 14 consumed a lot more memory than Visum 13 when loading networks with a lot of time series items. This error has been fixed. (14184)

Network comparisons

- Attributes not calculated in model transfer files: If an attribute is not calculated in the target network, it is excluded when generating the model transfer file, i.e. the difference is not saved if it is calculated in the source network. So far, such attributes were not mentioned in a warning either. A warning has now been added. (14215)
- Version file with shortest path search: Visum no longer crashes when additively reading in a version file with shortest path search (i.e. in the context of model transfer files or version comparisons). (14199)

Network Editor

- Aggregating and disaggregating line routes: If you aggregated and disaggregated line routes, the values of userdefined attributes were lost at affected vehicle journey items. This error has been fixed. (14227)
- Deleting enclaves: The Multi-edit special function 'Delete enclaves' for polygonal objects deleted no more than one enclave per call instead of all enclaves of the polygon. This error has been fixed. (13894)
- Editing the shape of line routes: If a line route has an 'antenna', i.e. for example a course A-B-C-B-D, and you fix the base point of the antenna which the line route traverses twice (B in the example) and then drag the end point (C) to this base point, a loop of the antenna remains via the link closest to B. This error has been fixed. (14187)
- Editing the shape of line routes: Visum does not crash any more if the line route of a ring line is edited in such a way that the end point and the start point no longer coincide, and if a block item exists for a vehicle journey section of one of its vehicle journeys. Nor does undoing an action which results in the deletion of a block item due to rerouting a line route cause a crash any more. (14197)
- Moving objects in the legend: If you reached the margin while shifting objects in the legend (backgrounds, texts, and polygons), so far, you could only move the objects away from the margin yet not along the margin. This error has been fixed. (13206)
- Multi-delete of POIs: Multi-deleting a large number of POIs (e.g. all POIs of a category) took too long; it has been accelerated considerably. (14185)
- Rerouting coupled line routes: If you edit the shape of a line route which has at least one coupled time profile and one of the newly used links has a link run time t_PuTSys of 0s for the transport system, the edit mode can only be terminated when deactivating the 'Retain coupling' option. It is not possible to retain the coupling which implies a rerouting of the line route of the coupled time profiles. This error has been fixed. (14163)

Procedure Sequence

Setting procedures active/inactive: Activating and inactivating procedure steps in the procedure sequence took too long, especially if the sequence contained demand procedures with a lot of demand strata. This error has been fixed. (14223)

Timetable Editor

- Editing the column width in the tabular timetable: Editing the column width in the stop sequence grid of the tabular timetable no longer causes a crash if the set of displayed vehicle journeys is empty. (14216)
- Including missing time profiles in the basic selection: The context menu function 'Include missing time profiles in basic line selection' in the line selection tree of the toolbar window 'Timetable lines' used to include the new siblings not only in the basic selection but also in the visible selection. This error has been corrected. (14206)
- Legend in graphical timetable: The 'Legend parameters' dialog for the legend of the graphical timetable can now be called via the 'Timetable (graphical)' menu or the context menu. (14164)
- Reading graphic parameters saved with Visum 13: When reading in timetable editor graphic parameters or version files saved with Visum 13, so far, the foreground and the background color of the tableau was not used for the tabular timetable if no classified display had been specified. This error has been fixed. (14148)
- Stop sequence after shifting a stop point: If you shifted a node stop point, traversed by a line route, in the network editor in such a way that it turned into a link stop point, the program generated an invalid stop sequence. This could lead to a crash. This error has been fixed. (14229)

Zooming in the graphical timetable: A crash no longer occurs when zooming in the graphical timetable. This crash only occurred in case of specific computer configurations. (14135)

VISUM Files

- Reading PrT paths from a network file: Only mandatory attributes and no values of other attributes were read (e.g. In selection, user-defined attributes) when reading PrT path items from a network file. This error has been fixed. (14167)
- Saving a version and closing the program: If you confirm 'Save version?' when closing Visum, the version file is not saved but Visum closes anyway. The saved data are lost. The error has been fixed. (14203)
- Saving a version with matrix swap file: More detailed error messages are now issued if an error occurs while saving a version file with an associated matrix swap file (for example insufficient memory). Above all, the currently loaded network is kept in the memory so that it can be saved in another location. (12099)
- Version files with EVA weighting matrices: Reading version files saved with Visum 13 or earlier which contained EVA weighting matrices was unnecessarily slow. It has thus been accelerated. (14191)

Breaking Changes

PuT Passenger Survey

Acceleration of plausibilization and direct assignment: The 'Plausibilization of survey data' procedure is now up to 15% faster and the 'Direct assignment' procedure up to 90% faster. In rare cases (where there are multiple line routes of the same line which have vehicle journeys matching the input data, i.e. such which run at the same time between the same stops), results may change once. (14210 C)

• New Features and Changes

Dialogs

Classification according to type number and the like: When setting a new attribute of the type 'type number', 'operator', 'valid day', 'vehicle combination', 'vehicle unit', 'parameter set' and 'fare system' on the classification pages of the graphic parameters dialog, you can now specify if you want to create a new class for each existing value. (14046)

Miscellaneous

• Modified mode: When executing a procedure sequence with 'Save version file' as last procedure, the network was no longer classified as modified any more (i.e. no asterisk after the file name in the title bar, no prompt to save the version file when closing the network). (13656)

Timetable Editor

• Access to the filter dialog: In both timetables (tabular/graphical), you can now access the filter dialog of the line filter again with a right-click on the filter icon in the tool bar of the timetable. (14146)

Fixed Bugs

Data Model

Access to list of all matrices: Listing all matrices no longer triggers a crash if external matrices exist, for example when adding procedure 'Edit matrix' and subsequently selecting the reference object. (14154)

Dialogs

Inserting bars in graphic parameters: Visum does not crash anymore if you try to insert a bar anywhere but in the last position which uses auto scaling and displays an attribute which is also displayed by another bar. (14132)

Filters

Infinite loop caused by filter on node topology attributes: If a version file contained a filter with a condition that used attributes which enforced the existence of node topologies for nodes (for example 'Number legs'), an infinite loop occurred when opening the version file. This error has been fixed. (14031)

Formulas

Rounding of floating-point number target attributes: When reading in version files or procedure parameter files from Visum version 12.5 or older which contain the procedure step 'Edit attribute' and for which the 'Round' option has been activated despite a target attribute of the type floating-point (this will have no effect in Visum 12.5 or older), the round operator is falsely included in the formula so that the execution of the procedure generates different values than in Visum 12.5. This error has been fixed. (14144)

Graphics

- Dashed boundary of polygonal objects of the type point: If you specified a dashed boundary for a polygonal object of the type point and later on a continuous display, the (continuous) lines were joined incorrectly. This error has been fixed. (14119)
- Legend and line bars: Drawing the legend no longer causes a crash after rearranging network objects in the graphic parameters for the filling of line bars. (14165)
- Slow image buildup: Even if the display of turn volumes was deactivated in the graphic parameters, the program used to calculate the minimum and the maximum of the turn attributes used in bars if the automatic scaling was switched on for these bars. This slowed the drawing of the network window down. This error has been fixed. (14120)

Main window

Crash due to undocked window: Reading a version file with the user preference 'Window configuration: Apply from version file, otherwise reset.' no longer causes a crash if the focus lies on a previously undocked window (e.g. a list). (14116)

Network Editor

Removing profile points after re-routing: Profile points could no longer be deleted after re-routing a line route. The error message 'Vehicle journey does not traverse time profile item' was issued instead. This error has been fixed. (14108)

Other Procedures

Intersect: Executing the 'Intersect' procedure or intersecting within the framework of Multi-edit in the network editor no longer causes a crash if the source attribute of the source object has an empty value. (14151)

PuT assignment

- Editing of fares: If you edit the fares of a ticket type by changing the number of fare points for an entry, the fares of existing PuT paths are not updated. Even after a new assignment, the values are now refreshed. This does not apply when editing the fare for a number of fare points. This error has been fixed. (14054)
- Slowdown of assignment with matrix time series: So far, the timetable-based assignment was 2-4 times slower in Visum 14 than the same assignment in Visum 13 when using matrix time series with a large number of matrices or very refined time series intervals. (14143)
- Timetable-based assignment with shortest path search: In connection with shortened vehicle journeys, in particular cases, the shortest path variant of the timetable-based assignment could generate invalid connections, namely such that used shortened vehicle journeys beyond their own extend. This could lead to a crash in the impedance calculation of the assignment or when accessing such invalid paths later on. (14014)

Schematic line diagram

Deleting labeling forms: If you deleted labeling forms in the graphic parameters of the schematic line diagram and subsequently selected a new labeling form for the display of an edge, the display did not always use the settings of this labeling form but the default labeling form. This error has been fixed. (14150)

Timetable Editor

- Displaying user-defined attributes: If you displayed user-defined attributes of vehicle journey items, calling the tabular timetable could cause a crash after terminating and restarting Visum. This error has been fixed. (14134)
- Hidden starts/ends of vehicle journeys: The arrows for hidden starts/ends of vehicle journeys now also point in the right direction if they start at segments which are wrapped beyond the time axis. (14113)
- Hiding stops without stop events: If the 'Hide stops without stop event' option of a stop sequence was active, the set of displayed members of the stop sequence was not refreshed when changing the visible selection in the line selection. This error has been fixed. (14101)

VISUM Files

- Reading of matrix time series: Matrix time series with a lot of entries are now read in much faster from the demand file (*.dmd). (14155)
- Time series of matrix numbers within demand files: Demand files (*.dmd) containing time series of matrix number which were created using Visum 13 or earlier versions lost all the matrix numbers when reading with Visum 14. This bug has been fixed. (14172)

• New Features and Changes

COM

Executing procedures: A procedure sequence started from a VBS script file via Procedures. Execute is no longer cancelled if it contains Python scripts or Add-ins which use wxPython. (13638)

Demand Procedures

Tour-based model distribution/mode choice: For demand strata with no home trips, the calculation is terminated early in order to save computation time. (13988)

Foreign Formats

OpenStreetMap import: The importer now also reads faces if their edges are not listed in the right order in the source file. (14028)

PrT Assignment

- Blocking back calculation: The blocking back calculation on the basis of LUCE assignments has been accelerated and now has the same computation time as on the basis of other assignment variants. (14088)
- LUCE: For the internal calculation, nodes are now only "exploded" where absolutely necessary. This reduces the computation time of the procedure, in some networks by half. (14078 •)

Timetable Editor

- By default, the layout of the tabular timetable now contains editable attributes for dimension, vehicle combination, operator and valid day. These attributes are displayed in drop-down lists which contain both number and code or name. (14075)
- Separation of the tables in the tabular timetable: The visual separation of the three different tables in the tabular timetable has been softened by placing the toggles 'Show vehicle journey sections' (for the table in the middle) and 'Vehicle journeys/Vehicle journey sections' (for the lower table) in the tool bar of the tabular timetable. In return, the row headers in the vehicle section table are displayed slightly darker. (13910)
- User-defined attributes for vehicle journey items: In the stop sequence, you can now also edit user-defined attributes for vehicle journey items. (6238)

VISUM Files

Graphic parameters file: A new XML-based file format (*.gpax) is now available besides the familiar *.gpa file. It can be opened or saved directly in the graphic parameters dialog and up to now contains exactly the graphic settings provided in this dialog. Specific graphic network objects (for example backgrounds) and parameters of graphic tools (e.g. flow bundle, isochrones etc.) are not included. However, there will be an XML format for those tools at a later point in time. (9709)

Fixed Bugs

Add-Ins

- Add-In 'Import Google Transit Feed': When using Add-In 'Import Google Transit Feed', a warning is now issued if no license exists for a calendar. All vehicle journeys are imported as daily in this case. (14053)
- Matrix Convolution: The procedure is now faster if one of the input matrices is constantly = 0. (13951)
- Run VBA: This Add-in can now also handle relative paths in the input attributes. (14083)

COM

Access to matrix values: The IMatrix.SetValuesDouble method now also accepts the return values of IMatrix.GetValuesDouble as argument when called from VBA. (14033)

- Editing filter conditions: If a filter condition referred to an attribute with a subattribute, a false error message was issued when accessing the attributes LOWERBOUND, UPPERBOUND or FILTEROPERATOR at the IFilterCondition object via AttValue, stating that the filter attribute was not found. This error has been fixed. (14066)
- IExportANMPara: Invalid attribute IDs are now rejected with an error message. (12161)
- Setting the text sizing factor: A change of the text sizing factor via
- INetworkBaseGPA::SetTextSizingFactorForScreen now takes immediate effect in the graphic display. (14073)
 Timetable editor: COM methods for reading the tabular timetable now always deliver length attributes contained in the table in the specified unit (e.g. km or mi), and not automatically in meters. (14007)

Data Model

- Block items at modified vehicle journey sections: If you extended or shortened a vehicle journey section via the dialog, block items defined on this section were not adjusted. This error has been fixed. (13749)
- User-defined attributes: By mistake, the names of user-defined attributes were translated on the user interface when Visum accessed them via relations. This error has been fixed. (14093)

Demand Procedures

- Creating a procedure sequence for a demand model: If you created a procedure sequence for a demand model in the Demand models dialog using the 'Create procedure sequence' button, incorrect formulas were generated in the procedure steps of the group 'Matrix aggregation'. These steps could not be executed. The error has been fixed. (14063)
- Kalibri: Since "matrix references" are flexible in Visum 14 and no longer permanently allocated in the data model, the Kalibri option "Save the calculated matrix as distribution matrix of the demand stratum" has become redundant. It has been removed from the surface. (14107)

Dialogs

- Classification by enumeration type: No more crash when selecting an attribute which is an enumeration type with named values as classification attribute in the graphic parameters dialog. (14137)
- Copying values to the clipboard: When copying length attributes from a dialog table (e.g. for user-defined attributes) to the clipboard, it now contains the original values from the view and no longer the lengths converted into meters. (14103)
- Line route dialog: Warnings issued while using the line route dialog are no longer displayed in a separate floating dialog but, as usual, in a dialog that has to be confirmed in order to continue working. (13600)
- Modal dialogs and progress dialogs: In several situations, a process is started with a progress dialog out of a modal dialog (e.g. additive reading of network files, multi-editing links / deleting collinear points, import of PuT supply from Visum). In all of these cases, the dialog became non-modal afterwards, i.e. other actions could, for example, be triggered via the menu while the dialog was open before the initially started process ended. This led to possible malfunctions or even a crash. This error has been fixed. (11557)

Foreign Formats

- Import of PuT supply from Visum: The parameters detour factor and supplement are now considered correctly during the import. A warning is issued if the specified attributes do not exist in the source network. (13927)
- Import PuT supply from Visum: In the parameters dialog for the import of the PuT supply from Visum, the program used to display the attribute selection of the target network for both networks when selecting attributes for the comparison attribute of stop points. This error has been corrected, i.e. the attribute selection of the source network is displayed for the stop points in the source network, so that even user-defined attributes, which are defined only in the source network, can be used as comparison attributes. (13976)
- Shapefile export: Texts are now cut off at 255 characters when exporting string attributes in order to fulfill the format specifications and to ensure the error-free import of such files. (14112)

Formulas

- Crash caused by deep nesting: Formula attributes with particularly deep nesting (about 25 brackets) could trigger a crash. This error has been fixed. (14080)
- IF function: Inside the IF function, only the expression that applies according to the IF condition is now evaluated. Depending on the complexity of the contained expressions, this can save a lot of computation time. (14117)

Graphics

- Background maps: If no internet connection exists while starting Visum, yet later on a connection exists, Bing maps are automatically available again from this point in time. (13619)
- Background maps: On some computers, the display of background maps (Bing maps or similar) used to fail because of the proxy authentication. This error has been fixed. (14100)

- Boundaries of polygons: The boundaries of polygons (e.g. for zones or territories) are now displayed as in Visum 13, without disruptive "jags". (14110)
- Line bar display: The visibility of the label of a line bar no longer depends on the standard bar parameters of the same bar. (14071)

Listings

Node list: The calculation of analysis rows no longer leads to a crash if node geometries are generated as a result. (14044)

Network comparisons

- Network merge mode: On some computer, the program used to crash at the beginning of the network merge mode. This error has been fixed. (14089)
- Version comparisons: The project directory specified for version files now applies to files used in version comparisons. Relative paths can thus also be used. (14076)

Network Editor

- Editing the shape of links and polygons: The dialogs which are used to edit the shape of links and polygons now also open inside the Visum main window if Visum runs on the second screen. (12224)
- Tabular editing of line route: If you edited a new line route only tabularly and the run times of the used system routes matched the PuT run times of the used links, you could not exit the floating dialog with OK and had to cancel the action. This error has been fixed. (14036)
- Undo: In the "Insert" mode for links and screenlines, you can use the Undo functionality again via the shortcut Ctrl+Z. (14074)

Other Procedures

"Edit attribute" procedure: *.ver or *.par files created with Visum 12.5 in which the "Edit attribute" procedure set a length attribute to a constant (e.g. "2 km") were not imported correctly into Visum 13 or 14. The constant was set to the internal meter value in this case. This conversion error has been fixed. (14111)

PuT Assignment

Parameter 'Consider connectiuons with DeltaT > 0, if connections with DeltaT = 0 exists': If the parameter 'Consider connectiuons with DeltaT > 0, if connections with DeltaT = 0 exists' is deactivated and if there are no connections with DeltaT = 0 for some given time interval, every connection was assigned the volume 10[/](-n), where n is the number of decimal places defined as 'Preciusion of computation' by the general procedure settings. If volume data is not rounded at all, no connection would be assigned any volume in that case. This bug has been fixed. (14138)

Schematic Line Diagram

Shifting centered labels: Shifting centered labels no longer leads to a crash. (14106)

Breaking Changes

PrT Assignment

UCE: For the internal calculation, nodes are now only "exploded" where absolutely necessary. This reduces the computation time of the procedure, in some networks by half. This change can lead to different assignment results in the context of the accuracy of convergence. (14078)

New Features and Changes

Add-Ins

- Add-In 'Import Google Transit Supply': So far, all stop points were opened for all transport systems when importing data using the Add-In 'Import Google Transit Supply'. Now they are opened only for those transport systems that are actually required. (13939)
- Add-in 'Import Google Transit Supply': So far, the 'Import Google Transit Supply' Add-In did not handle umlauts in identifiers correctly. This error has been fixed. (14002)

Add-In 'Import Google Transit Supply': The 'Import Google Transit Supply' Add-In has been accelerated significantly. (11681)

COM

- Access to 'Read filter': You can now access the parameters of the 'Read filter' procedure in COM. Add-Ins

Add-In 'Matrix Convolution': A version file saved with Visum 12 or earlier versions which contained parameters for the 'Matrix Convolution' Add-In could not be run with Visum 12.5 or later versions. This error has been fixed. (13981)

COM

- Adding and removing procedures: Using 'Undo' and 'Redo' or removing a procedure interactively from the procedure sequence no longer causes a crash, if a procedure step has been inserted or deleted previously via COM (methods 'AddOperation' or 'RemoveOperation'). (13982)
- Messages during start of program as COM server: When starting Visum as COM server, modal message windows could pop up and prevent the start of the program. This error has been fixed. Messages from this phase can be found in the usual places, e.g. the log file or the message file. (13992)
- Modifying block items: So far, the status of the block was not adjusted properly when editing block items via COM (e.g. by setting attribute values using AttValue). This error has been fixed. (13297)

Filter for OD pairs on PuT paths: Visum no longer crashes when evaluating the filter for OD pairs with filter conditions on PuT paths which have fares. (13997)

Foreign Formats

- Import of PuT supply from Visum: A crash does not occur any more during the import of PuT supply from Visum, if the target network is empty (no nodes and/or no links). Furthermore, nodes, links, and stop points are created only once in the target network, if line routes of different transport systems require the creation of new infrastructure. Instead, the newly created stop points and links are opened for the additional transport systems. (13933)

PuT path lists with fares: The program does not crash any more when displaying PuT path lists (PuT paths, PuT path legs), if fares are displayed as attributes and analysis rows are inserted. (14013)

PuT Line Blocking

Forced chainings during marginal hours: Forced chainings of vehicle journey sections starting after 24h were not regarded correctly in the line blocking calculation. This error has been fixed. (13991)

Schematic line diagram, Timetable Editor

Calculating the stop sequence based on marked edges: Time profiles of marked edges were not always inserted in consistent direction into the line selection, when opening the timetable editor in the schematic line diagram based on the undirected edges marked and adjusting the line selection and the stop sequence. When calculating the stop sequence, this led to the display of line routes in forward direction instead of reverse direction when inserting additional stops. This error has been fixed. (13955)

Timetable Editor

Line selection in the 'Timetable lines' tool window: The 'Line selection' dialog opens much faster when opened in the 'Timetable lines' tool window. (13918)

Breaking Changes

COM

Reading filters: You can now read the current filter conditions. Multi-deleting nodes (with two legs): Memory consumption went up when deleting multiple nodes with two legs using the option that connects the links in case of a great number of nodes to be deleted despite using the 'Clear Undo stack to save RAM' option. This error has been fixed. At the same time, the run time has been accelerated and misleading messages regarding the positioning of stop points are suppressed if stop points are not involved. Other Procedures

Intersect' procedure: The progress indicator of the 'Intersect' procedure has been improved. (13856)

PrT assignment

- Multiple assignments with MPA and blocking back calculations: Visum no longer crashes when successively calculating multiple PrT assignments for different demand segments in a procedure sequence while both MPA and the blocking back calculation are active. (13885)

Timetable Editor

Scrolling in the tabular timetable: The program no longer crashes when scrolling in the tabular timetable if not all of the vehilce journey sections fit the screen. (13917)

Timetable Editor, Network Editor

Deleting multiple lines: When deleting multiple lines, stop sequences could still contain references to the deleted lines. Subsequent operations, particularly saving a version file or the layout file of the timetable lines, then led to a crash. This error has been fixed. (13898)

VISUM Files

References to sig files: If a version file contains signal controls with external controls (VISSIG) but no VISSIG license exists, the program no longer issues messages when reading the version file. The signal control then acts like a signal group based internal fixed time control and uses the green times provided by the Visum data model. Extension of shortest path search for PuT: The extension periods can now be accessed via the COM interface. The default value for the extension periods is 86400 and therefore differs from the previous value which depended on the analysis period. (13429 ⁽³⁾)

- Filtering in Path lists: The enumeration routeFilter_filterFromZoneFilter of routeFilterT is now always active, i.e. is also effective in combination with other members of routeFilterT enumeration. If no origin zone is given, the origin zone filter does not take effect. (13710 ^(c))
- MapMatcher: The default matching algorithm of the MapMatcher has been changed from 'Incremental' to 'Global'. You can reproduce the old behaviour by setting the attribute 'Algorithm' of the IMapMatchinParameter-object to '0'. (13150 ⁽¹⁾)

Timetable editor

Shift vehicle journeys to a different line: When shifting vehicle journeys to a different line it is possible to aggregate line routes if the target line contains line routes that are compatible to the line route of the shifted vehicle journey.
