## ✓ Fixed Bugs

### Add-Ins

- ✓ Output of the assignment statistics in the add-in "Reporting PrT Assignment": Running the add-in "Reporting PrT Assignment" led to an error message if the output of the assignment statistics was enabled. This error has been corrected. **(17279)**
- ✓ TransCAD import with polygon points of links: For links with polygon points, the import of a TransCAD network with the add-in 'Import TransCAD Network' used to generate one polygon point too many, which was then located right on the From-Node or To-Node. This error has been fixed. **(16583)**
- ✓ TransCAD import with special characters: The import of a TransCAD network with the add-in 'Import TransCAD Network' failed if the input data contained special characters that could not be converted. This error has been fixed by skipping the affected values during the import. **(17197)**

### COM

- ✓ Path settings for layout files of timetables: If you opened a layout file with a relative path via COM (method OpenLayout at IBlockDisplay, ITabularTimetable or IGraphicalTimetable) for one of the timetables, the project directory for timetable layouts did not take effect, but the project directory for layout files of the old timetable editor (up to Visum 13), which is no longer accessible interactively. This error has been fixed. **(17323)**

### COM, Visum Files

- ✓ Reading in very old network files: If the import of very old network files failed, the import was still considered successfully completed. In particular, you did not get an error message in case of an error when you called the COM method LoadNet. This error has been corrected. **(17278)**

### Demand Procedures

- ✓ High memory consumption with P+R: The memory consumption of the result data structures of the 'P+R lot choice' procedure has been reduced considerably. Version files that contain such a result thus use less memory once loaded. **(16096)**

### Dialogs

- ✓ Crash after editing graphic parameters of a POI category: A crash no longer occurs when closing the graphic parameters dialog if the graphic parameters of a POI category are edited first and this change is saved in the subdialog for this POI category, yet then the graphic parameters dialog is exited via 'Cancel'. **(17315)**
- ✓ Editing the course of line routes, system routes, PrT paths: The floating dialog which can be used to influence or complete the edit of the course of a line route, a system route, a PrT path, or a link sequence has been truncated if a text magnification factor greater than 100% was set for the screen display. This error has been corrected. **(17295)**
- ✓ Preview of polygons in graphic parameters dialog: In case of narrow line widths, in the preview, the polygon frame could only be seen at the top and on the left side for various polygon graphic parameters. The bottom and the right side were missing or drawn asymmetrically. This error has been fixed. **(17259)**
- ✓ Progress dialogs do not block application: Under certain circumstances, progress dialogs displayed in case of a lengthy action did not block the interface reliably. It was possible to start a new action before the running action was finished, e.g. the procedure sequence while reading a version file, which led to indefinite consequences or even program crashes. This error has been fixed. **(16239)**

### Graphics

- ✓ Missing route courses in screenshot of procedure sequence: If you created a screenshot in a script that was run in the procedure sequence during procedure step 'Run script', it lacked the 'Route course' layer. This error has been fixed. **(17399)**

## I/O Interfaces

- ✔ 'PuT supply from Visum' import: If, in the source network, a line route traversed a shared section in both directions during the import of a PuT supply from Visum, unnecessary loops were sometimes inserted in the line route course in the target network when bundling with already existing line routes (option). This error has been fixed. **(16528)**
- ✔ Repeated railML import in one session: If you repeatedly opened the parameters dialog for the railML import in one Visum session, the lists to select the primary and secondary matching attributes on tab 'Transfer to target network' only contained the entries of the previous pass instead of all items available in the railML file. This error has been fixed. **(17080)**

## Junction Editor

- ✔ Editing an external signal control: As soon as a signal group of a signal control with control type Vissig or RBC was marked in the Junction Editor, all menu items and tool bar buttons were inactive. This error has been corrected. **(17301)**

## Network Editor

- ✔ Standard dwell time for lengthened line routes: If you lengthened an existing line route (at the start or end), the standard dwell time was not transferred to the previous start point/end point, i.e. the dwell time here was always 0. This error has been fixed. **(17458)**

## PrT Assignment

- ✔ LUCE stops at end of proportionalising process: In certain cases, the calculation of the PrT assignment LUCE was not completed if one of the two options to optimize the proportionality of route volumes at meshes was activated and the calculation ran on multiple cores. This error has been fixed. **(17337)**
- ✔ Useless dispersion parameters in Tribut-Equilibrium assignment and Tribut-Equilibrium\_Lohse: A crash no longer occurs if a dispersion parameter or the median is not positive in the distribution functions for an OD pair in a PrT assignment variant Tribut-Equilibrium or Tribut-Equilibrium\_Lohse. From now on, the assignment will not be executed in such a case. **(17331)**

## PuT Assignment

- ✔ Connections in departure extension of timetable-based assignment: If a departure extension is used in a timetable-based assignment and the option 'Delete connections that lie entirely within the departure/arrival extension' has been selected for the preselection, connections within the actual assignment time interval were also deleted under certain circumstances. This error has been fixed. **(17336)** 🚫

## PuT Operating Indicators

- ✔ Executing the 'PuT operating indicators' procedure on multiple cores could lead to sporadic crashes. This error has been fixed. **(17368)**

## Timetable Editor

- ✔ Missing scroll bars after maximizing the tabular timetable: If you scrolled far to the right in the tabular timetable, so that some vehicle journeys were not displayed at the left margin and then enlarged the window (e.g. by maximizing it), these vehicle journeys were still not displayed and the scroll bar disappeared. The vehicle journeys could only be reached via the keyboard. This error has been fixed. **(16804)**

## Visum Files

- ✔ Reading in attribute files while shortest path search is active: If a shortest path search was active in the network, reading in attribute files for network objects which affect the shortest path search (e.g. links) was extremely slow. This error has been fixed. **(15285)**

## 🚫 Breaking Changes

### PuT Assignment

- 🚫 Connections in departure extension of timetable-based assignment: If a departure extension is used in a timetable-based assignment and the option 'Delete connections that lie entirely within the departure/arrival extension' has been selected for the preselection, connections within the actual assignment time interval were also deleted under certain circumstances. This error has been fixed. This leads to changes in the assignment result when using a departure extension in combination with this option. **(17336)** ✔

## ✔ Fixed Bugs

### Add-Ins

- ✔ Progress dialog in VisumPy: If you closed the 'ProgressDlg' from the TK package of the Visum Python library VisumPy, an error message was issued so far. This error has been fixed. **(17235)**

### COM

- ✔ SaveDemandFile without layout: If the file name of a layout file was specified while calling method IIO.SaveDemandFile but no file was found using this path, the method was executed anyway instead of canceled with an error. This error has been fixed. **(17086)**

### Demand Procedures

- ✔ 'EVA weighting' run time when using many cores: More run time was needed when using a lot of computer cores to calculate the procedure 'EVA weighting'. This error has been fixed. **(17239)**
- ✔ Crash P+R leg split: A crash no longer occurs when running procedure 'P+R leg split' if a demand stratum is specified as reference object for which no results are available from the procedure 'P+R lot choice'. **(17131)**

### Graphics

- ✔ Diagrams in legend: In the legend, the formatting of the values for the diagram label was ignored for the scaling of diagrams, in particular the set number of decimal places. This error has been fixed. **(14765)**
- ✔ No link display in Junction Editor and during turn volume export: Sometimes links were not drawn reliably in the Junction Editor and when exporting turn volumes. This error has been fixed. **(17088)**

### I/O Interfaces

- ✔ Passenger trip chains of parallel vehicle journey sections during railML import: If a source vehicle journey and a chained target vehicle journey had multiple parallel vehicle journey sections on the same calendar days, passenger trip chains were generated from different vehicle journey sections of the source vehicle journey to the same vehicle journey section of the target vehicle journey during a railML import. In many cases, this error could be fixed. **(17266)**
- ✔ PuT import from Visum generates loops: In certain constellations, the import of 'PuT supply from Visum' used to generate loops, i.e. links whose From-Node and To-Node are identical. These links could not be inserted into the network. This error has been fixed. **(17256)**

### Lists

- ✔ Deleting activities while a matrix list is open: In large networks with a lot of matrices, deleting activities used to be very slow if a matrix list was open at the same time. This error has been fixed. **(17240)**
- ✔ Slow export of PrT path lists with flow bundle paths: The export of PrT path lists restricted to flow bundle paths took too long and was thus accelerated considerably. **(17114)**

### Main Window

- ✔ Copy/Paste in the Quick view: If a row was marked in a list that was not synchronized, the actions 'Copy attributes' and 'Paste attributes' in the Quick view affected the object corresponding to this list row and not the current global marking (shown in the Quick view). This error has been fixed. **(16299)**

### Matrix Editor

- ✔ Saving the filtered matrix view as matrix: Saving a filtered matrix view (e.g. considering the OD pair filter) in one of the suitable formats (e.g. \$O) no longer causes a crash. **(17233)**

### Network Editor

- ✔ Deleting all faces at main nodes: If operation 'Delete all faces' was called for a marked main node, a query was issued asking whether the user wanted to continue. If you answered 'No', all faces were deleted anyway. This error has been fixed. **(17132)**

- ✔ Moving polygon points with territory data: If a network contained result data for territories (e.g. from territory-based evaluations of the 'PuT operating indicators' procedure) and a polygon point of a territory was moved, a query was issued asking to discard the results for territories. If you said 'No', you were caught in a loop: the question was asked again immediately. This error has been fixed. **(16245)**
- ✔ Rerouting line routes/system routes/PrT paths: A crash no longer occurs when rerouting a line route/system route/PrT path if routing via closed links is prohibited in the parameters. This fix, however, leads to the recurrence of the preview error fixed in Visum 16.01-05 with VISUM-16961, which will be fixed in the next service pack. **(17223)**
- ✔ Stop points traversed more than once: The dialog to select the line or system route item in case of stop points traversed more than once or nodes when editing the course of a line route now opens when hovering the mouser over the stop point or node, not only when clicking the object. The error has been fixed. **(17158)**

## PrT Assignment

- ✔ Editing impedance definition: Changing the impedance definition for a PrT transport system in the general procedure parameters could lead to a crash in certain cases. This error has been fixed. **(17133)**
- ✔ Simple impedance definition with t0: If the simple variant of the impedance definition was used for a PrT transport system with attribute t0 (travel time in unloaded network) as impedance, for connectors, the value t0 was not taken into account for so far. This error has been fixed. **(17153)** 🚫
- ✔ Temporary closure of links in DUE: The calculation of the Dynamic User Equilibrium (DUE) no longer leads to a crash if a link is closed by specifying a time-varying capacity of 0 or a time-varying speed of 0 for a certain time. However, such links remain open with of a very low speed and can thus have small volumes despite of the closure. **(16912)** 🚫

## PuT Assignment

- ✔ Connection import with fares: The import of connections with fares no longer causes a crash if the volumes of some of the read-in demand segments are saved with different demand segments. **(17110)**

## Timetable Editor

- ✔ Crash when switching the network while the Transfers display of regular services is open: A crash no longer occurs when switching the network (e.g. when loading a version file) if the Transfers display of regular services is open and 'Keep configuration' is set for windows in the user preferences. **(15021)**

## Visum Files

- ✔ Cancellation of network import when reading transport systems: A crash no longer occurs if a message is issued for table 'Transport systems' while reading a network file and you cancel the import. **(17113)**
- ✔ Files with two periods in name: So far, it was not possible to open a graphic parameter file, filter file or list layout file from the project directory via one of the drop-down lists if the name and the file extension were separated by two periods (scheme '<name>.<extension>'). This error has been fixed. **(17151)**
- ✔ Impedance functions with formula attributes: Attributes of detailed impedance functions were checked too early when reading in a version file, so that set formula attributes were considered invalid and were thus lost. This error has been fixed. **(17180)**
- ✔ Message 'Preparing version file export...' when writing a version file: The message 'Preparing version file export' was displayed for an unnecessarily long time if the line route course layer was switched on and the calculation of the route courses was not finished yet. This error has been fixed. **(17186)**
- ✔ Network files with more than 65536 characters in a row: Reading a network file with more than 65536 characters in the last row no longer leads to a crash. **(17147)**
- ✔ Setting minimum green times using model transfer files: If a model transfer file contained modified minimum green times of stages, so far, the program did not check whether the existing information on green time start and green time end was consistent with the new minimum green times. This could lead to the generation of networks that could not be read in again when saving a version file and then trying to open the same file. This error has been fixed. **(17169)**
- ✔ Version files with a lot of screenlines: Reading in version files with screenlines used to be inefficient. Files with a great number of screenlines could thus de facto not be read in. This error has been fixed. **(17126)**

## 🚫 Breaking Changes

### PrT Assignment

- 🚫 Simple impedance definition with t0: If the simple variant of the impedance definition was used for a PrT transport system with attribute t0 (travel time in unloaded network) as impedance, for connectors, the value t0 was not taken into account for so far. This error has been fixed. This changes the skim matrix for affected transport systems as well as the result of any PrT assignment if there are zones with more than one usable connector. **(17153)** ✔

- ❗ Temporary closure of links in DUE: The calculation of the Dynamic User Equilibrium (DUE) no longer leads to a crash if a link is closed by specifying a time-varying capacity of 0 or a time-varying speed of 0 for a certain time. However, such links remain open with of a very low speed and can thus have small volumes despite of the closure. (16912) ✓

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## ✓ Fixed Bugs

### COM

- ✓ Adding a matrix to IMatrixTable via COM: A crash no longer occurs when adding a matrix to an open IMatrixTable object if the new matrix is not compatible with the matrices already open in IMatrixTable (regarding the network object reference or the dimension). (16090)

### COM-API

- ✓ Running a script while Visum runs as a service: If Visum was started from a service and a script was run in Visum in the course of this, the program froze when it was closed. This error has been fixed. (17031)
- ✓ Shortest path search or PrT assignment after renumbering zones: If the number of a zone was changed via COM, neither PrT shortest path searches nor PrT assignments could be carried out afterwards, because paths were no longer found. This error has been fixed. (17005)

### Data Model

- ✓ Reading user-defined attributes from network files: If you read a network file that included a user-defined attribute and the network file did not contain all optional columns, default values different from those set when creating an attribute of the same type were sometimes set in the dialog. This led to different consequential errors, for example: attributes of the type 'File' were not generated and when opening the Edit dialog for this user-defined attribute, false error messages were issued. This error has been fixed. (17007)

### Demand Procedures

- ✓ Wrong success message during 'EVA distribution/mode choice': If balancing failed during the procedure for a mode that was not interchangeable, depending on the sequence, the procedure was still finished with a success message and the procedure sequence continued. This error has been fixed. (16886)

### Dialogs

- ✓ User-defined colors in graphic parameters: If more than 16 user-defined colors were selected in the color selection of a graphic parameters' dialog, a crash could occur in the further course of the session. This error has been fixed. (17037)

### Formulas

- ✓ Integer target attribute in 'Edit attribute' procedure: When reading in 'version or procedure parameter files, which were saved with Visum 14 or earlier, in any contained procedure step 'Edit attribute' in which the target attribute was an integer but the formula was empty, this empty (but valid) formula was replaced by the invalid formula 'Floor()'. This error has been fixed. (17070)

### Graphical Procedures

- ✓ Flow bundle terms with supply restriction: If the definition of a PuT flow bundle is read from a version file or from a graphic parameters file, terms specified in the file for which restrictions of the supply existed only contained that part of the supply whose time profiles had a profile point at the network object. This error has been fixed. (17082)

### Graphics

- ✓ Internet maps under Windows 2008 Server and remote desktop: When using the operating system Window 2008 Server, in remote desktop sessions internet maps were not displayed in the network editor if the projection 'Sphere Mercator' was set. This error has been fixed. (17019)
- ✓ Outliers in route course layer: Display errors occurred in the route course layer if sections of the course were located outside of the display window. This error has been fixed. (16795)

### I/O Interfaces

- ✔ 'PuT supply from Visum' import: A time profile without a course was generated if the second last and the last line route item of a line route were mapped to the same location in the network during an import of PuT supply from Visum. As a consequence, such version files could not be loaded any more. This error has been fixed: a correct time profile is now generated. **(17061)**
- ✔ 'To length' at left out intermediate points during import of 'PuT supply from Visum': The 'To length' of line route items of the source network that were left out during the import were lost, either because only stop points were considered or because no suitable location could be found in the target network. This error has been fixed. **(17093)**
- ✔ HAFAS import with circular passenger trip chains: A crash no longer occurs during the HAFAS import if the data contains passenger trip chains that form a closed chain that does not reach the starting point again but a vehicle journey that exists further on in the chain (example: A->B->C->D->B->C...). **(16897)**
- ✔ HAFAS import: If inconsistent data (e.g. references to non-existing stops) was found in an optional file of the HAFAS data pool, the import was canceled so far instead of continued without the optional file. This error has been fixed. **(16957)**
- ✔ Routing problems during import of PuT supply from Visum: If two line route items from the origin network were mapped to the same location in the target network during import of PuT supply from Visum, the line route could not be inserted. This problem particularly occurred when using intermediate points. This error has been fixed. **(16881)**
- ✔ Shortened vehicle journeys in railML export: The arrival and departure times of vehicle journeys shortened at the front (i.e. vehicle journeys that do not start at the first time profile item) were shifted in the railML export. This error has been corrected. **(16937)**

## Matrix Editor

- ✔ Deleting zones while a Matrix Editor is open: A crash no longer occurs when deleting zones while a Matrix Editor is open. This error occurred only sporadically. **(16994)**
- ✔ Saving a filtered matrix view to file: Only the \$O format was available when saving a filtered matrix view to file from the Matrix Editor. This error has been fixed. **(17046)**

## Matrixeditor

- ✔ Adding a matrix to IMatrixTable via COM: A crash no longer occurs when adding a matrix to an open IMatrixTable object if the new matrix is not compatible with the matrices already open in IMatrixTable (regarding the network object reference or the dimension). **(16090)**

## Network Editor

- ✔ Crash when deleting a count location: Deleting a count location no longer causes a crash. This used to occur under certain circumstances. **(16909)**
- ✔ Crash when splitting zones: Splitting zones in the network editor used to cause a crash if the numbers of the new zones were not higher than the numbers of already existing zones. This bug has been fixed. **(17072)**
- ✔ Renumbering vehicle journeys in mode 'Lines': Calling the shortcut menu entry 'Renumber vehicle journeys' had no effect if the network editor was in mode 'Edit: Lines'. This error has been fixed. **(17038)**
- ✔ Rerouting line routes via closed links: When editing the course of a line route, in some cases the rerouting preview contained paths that led across closed links even if this was ruled out in the parameters. When confirming this new course, a message was issued stating that the new course could not be used as it contained closed links. This error has been fixed, i.e. the preview of routes now only contains links that are not closed, if possible, and can thus be used for the course. **(16961)**
- ✔ Response when starting 'Link sequence from shortest path search': So far, no graphical feedback was given when using function 'Link sequence from shortest path search' if you selected the start node for the shortest path search, but only after dragging a path. This error has been fixed. **(15411)**
- ✔ Shifting the display area while editing the shape of line routes: The display area could no longer be shifted or zoomed via keys while editing the shape of line routes, system routes, or PrT paths. This error has been fixed. Now you can use the arrow keys in particular to shift the display area. **(16785)**
- ✔ Splitting zones: Numbers that were already assigned to zones were sometimes suggested as zone numbers for new zones when splitting zones. This error has been fixed. **(17096)**

## PrT Assignment

- ✔ Impedance functions from XML procedure parameter files: A crash no longer occurs when executing a PrT assignment (different variants) if impedance functions were read from an XML procedure parameters file or from a version file saved with Visum 16 beforehand. **(17002)**
- ✔ Shortest path search or PrT assignment after renumbering zones: If the number of a zone was changed via COM, neither PrT shortest path searches nor PrT assignments could be carried out afterwards, because paths were no longer found. This error has been fixed. **(17005)**

## PrT Assignment, Visum Files

- ✔ VD functions with number 0 from earlier versions: Due to an error, some VD functions were created with the number 0 in earlier program versions. If such a network was saved as a version file with PTV Visum 16 and later read in again, the VD function concerned was missing. Now the numbers of VD functions are renumbered in the valid range when reading in version files concerned or binary procedure parameter files. The references of the links etc. to the VD functions are adjusted accordingly. **(17013)**

## Timetable Editor

- ✔ Aggregate functions in the tabular timetable: In the tabular timetable, if you displayed vehicle journeys grouped by service trip patterns and changed the aggregate function for an attribute, this change affected a row other than the one chosen. This error has been fixed. **(17104)**
- ✔ Graphic parameters for passive vehicle journey sections and items: In the tabular timetable, the settings for the text color and the background color of passive vehicle journey sections or vehicle journey items did not have an effect. The graphic parameters for passive vehicle journeys were used instead. This error has been fixed. **(16397)**
- ✔ Shortcut menu for vehicle journey sections in the tabular timetable: In the tabular timetable, the shortcut menu for vehicle journey sections was missing if exactly one vehicle journey was displayed with exactly one vehicle journey section. This error has been fixed. **(16030)**

## Visum Files

- ✔ Attribute allocation during import of attribute file: In the dialog for the allocation of attributes, attribute names were cut off in the 'Target attribute' column. This error has been fixed. **(16803)**
- ✔ Reading network files, table 'POI to Links': Reading a network file no longer leads to a crash if the 'POI to Links' table (POITOLINK) contains an entry that refers to two nodes that exist in the network yet are not connected by a link. **(17058)**

## Visum Files, Procedure Sequence

- ✔ User-defined attribute in Go To operation: If a 'Go To' procedure step was among the procedure parameters whose condition referred to a user-defined attribute, the set attribute was lost when saving and subsequently reading the version file. This error has been fixed. **(16887)**

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## + New Features and Changes

### I/O Interfaces

- + HAFAS data in UTF-8: HAFAS data can now also be imported if it is available in the form of text files in UTF-8 format. The format row '\*F', which may be contained at the start of each HAFAS file, is evaluated for this. **(16196)**

### ✔ Fixed Bugs

### ANM

- ✔ PuT export in case of undirected link stop points: Undirected link stop points were not handled correctly during the ANM export. This could lead to the loss of PuT lines that served these stop points during the transfer from PTV Visum to PTV Vissim via ANM. This error has been fixed. **(16748)**

### Add-Ins

- ✔ 'Calculate Matrix' without matrices: If the 'Calculate Matrix' add-in was run in a network that did not contain any matrices, the program issued no useful error message so far. This error has been fixed. **(16681)**

### COM

- ✔ Change of key attributes via SetMultiAttValues and related functions: The change of key attributes of objects, which can be reference objects for matrices (i.e. zones, main zones and stops areas), is not possible with the Multi-Edit functions such as SetMultiAttValues. However, no error message was issued so far and the operation was partially executed. This error is fixed, i.e. the execution is rejected correctly. **(16432)**

### COM-API

- ✔ Faulty system routes: A faulty system route used to be added to the network if, on the one hand, you entered an incomplete sequence of network items for the path using COM method `INet.AddSystemRoute` and, on the other hand, disabled the completion of the course through shortest path searches. The incomplete course of the system route could lead to subsequent program crashes. This error has been fixed: Visum no longer permits the creation of such system routes. **(16784)**
- ✔ Running scripts via COM: If you ran a script via the COM function `Visum.ExecuteScriptFile` and the script aborted with an exception, a dialog used to open, bringing the process to a stop. Furthermore, `ExecuteScriptFile` returned without an error, so that the calling code could not react to the exception. These errors have been fixed. **(16703)**

## Data Model

- ✔ Inserting the opposite direction of a line route: Inserting the opposite direction of a line route no longer leads to an infinite loop if it uses directed link stop points that do not exist yet in the opposite direction. **(16865)**
- ✔ Renaming and deleting transport systems with fares: Renaming and then deleting a (PuT) transport system in one session resulted in a faulty data model if at least one ticket type existed in the network (and thus supplements per transport system). As a consequence of this, version files could no longer be saved. This error has been fixed. **(16636)**

## Dialogs

- ✔ Adding an assessment type for EVA weighting: If you created an assessment type under 'Define assessment types' in the procedure parameters dialog of the 'EVA weighting' procedure, the name of the new assessment type was not displayed during entry. This bug has been fixed. **(16779)**
- ✔ Copy/Paste Modal Split during EVA distribution/mode choice: In the procedure parameters dialog of the 'EVA distribution/mode choice' procedure, the Standardized assessment tab displays 8 decimal places. If you copied these values and pasted them to a different row, the transferred value was rounded to 6 decimal places. This bug has been fixed. **(16782)**
- ✔ Notification bar for scenario management and stop sequence: In some languages the notification bar for the scenario management and the stop sequence showed no control elements any more, but parts of the code. This error has been fixed. **(16863)**

## Graphical Procedures

- ✔ Lengths with PuT Aux in shortest path search: The length displayed for path legs in the 'PuT shortest path search' list that were covered with a PuT Aux transport system did not correspond to the total length of the path leg but to the length of the first link of the path leg only. This error has been fixed. **(16868)**

## I/O Interfaces

- ✔ OpenStreetMap import with large IDs: In OpenStreetMap, the highest ID of an object has exceeded the range that can be represented by 32bit numbers. Such data could not be read in so far. This error has been fixed, i.e. OpenStreetMap data can now also be read in if it includes objects with IDs of such large sizes. **(16771)**

## Installation

- ✔ Automatic check out after license update: If there was a license among the licenses selected for automatic check out during program start, whose dongle has been updated, the automatic check out used to be canceled and the updated license data was retrieved. An 'unattended' program start (e.g. via COM) in particular could not be carried out. This error has been fixed: If there are other usable licenses apart from the updated license, the updated license is left out and the program is started with one of the known licenses. **(16884)**

## Lists

- ✔ Filtered PuT paths lists with PuT path filter and network changes: Visum no longer crashes in case of certain changes to the network that affect the fare model if a PuT path list is visible, which only displays the paths of the OD pair filter and this OD pair filter contains filter conditions on PuT paths, which in turn refer to fare data and are changed by the network change. **(16162)**

## Main Window

- ✔ 'Show messages' in procedures: The program no longer crashes if you click the ' Show messages' button (to open the message window) of the warning message during a parallelized procedure. **(16729)**
- ✔ Running procedures while the message window is open: Crashes no longer occur when running parallelized procedures while the message window is open. This error has been fixed. **(16756)**

## Matrix Editor



- ✔ Undoing/redoing changes to graphic parameters: A crash no longer occurs if you edit graphic parameters in the Matrix editor, close the editor, and subsequently undo or redo the changes to the graphic parameters. **(14907)**

## Network Comparisons

- ✔ Update of comparison attributes on formulas: The comparison attributes (such as "This network - x") of version comparisons were not adjusted when updating the version comparison or when opening a version file with version comparison if the compared attribute was a formula attribute whose formula uses a user-defined attribute that has changed due to the update. This error has been fixed. **(16783)**

## Network Editor

- ✔ Aggregating time profiles: When aggregating time profiles without the 'Time profiles with identical in-vehicle times and dwell times' option and coupled vehicle journeys existed on the time profiles, couplings could not be retained if in-vehicle times and/or dwell times of the partners changed in different ways. A separate message used to be issued for each affected coupling in this case without the possibility of disabling further messages. This error has been fixed. **(16269)**

## PrT Assignment

- ✔ Demand from nested formula matrix: A crash no longer occurs when running an assignment (PrT or PuT) with MPA if the demand matrix is a formula matrix which itself uses another formula matrix. **(16617)**

## PuT Assignment

- ✔ Calculating skim discomfort without connections: A crash no longer occurs if the skim 'Discomfort' shall be calculated in the context of the timetable-based assignment or skim matrix calculation, yet this is not possible due to vehicle journey volumes or because no connections were saved and the user confirms the issued warning nevertheless. **(16797)**
- ✔ Capacity-restricted assignment and MPA: If you carried out a second search in a capacity-restricted assignment or an assignment with sharing transport systems while MPA was on (percentage connectors), the same path could be generated more than once (and thus attracted more demand without justification). This error has been corrected. **(16870)**

- ✔ Person kilometers / person hours in case of different operators on a time profile: If different vehicle journeys of the same time profile had different operators, so far, person kilometers / person miles rendered on these vehicle journeys were not saved to the corresponding indicators. This error has been fixed. **(16701)**

## Timetable Editor

- ✔ Crash when changing the line selection: A crash no longer occurs when adding a line / line route / time profile to the line selection if a new network has previously been opened in the same session. **(16821)**

## Visum Files

- ✔ Formula attributes in model transfer files: When reading a model transfer file, which also contains changes to user-defined formula attributes, these changes were not adopted if the formula referred to other attributes that did not yet exist at this time - for example because they can be found further down in the file and are therefore read later. This error has been corrected. **(16535)**
- ✔ Time formats depending on the country setting: So far, the start time and the end time of the execution of procedures were saved in a format that depended on the current country setting of the computer when saving procedure parameters XML files and the version files. This error has been fixed. **(10752)**
- ✓ Graphics parameter dialog for bars: On the page of the object selection in the graphic parameter dialog labels could not be read when an enlarged representation of text is selected in the Windows system settings. This error has been fixed. **(16355)**
- ✓ Utility definition in procedure 'Tour-based model - Combined trip distribution / mode choice': When copying and pasting the utility definition on tab 'Distribution Utility' of the parameters dialog of the 'Tour-based model - Combined trip distribution / mode choice' procedure, an additional plus sign was inserted in the formula. This error has been fixed. **(16698)**

### Filters

- ✓ PuT assignment statistics with an OD relation filter after a TSys-based assignment: After a tsys-based assignment in the PuT assignment statistics the total number of passenger trips was always zero and the number of passenger trips without connection was negativ if an OD filter was active (even if effectively all OD relations were active). Also, corresponding attributes of zones were affected. This error has been fixed. **(16626)**

### Graphical Procedures

- ✓ PuT shortest path search, changing parameters: A crash no longer occurs if option 'Consider only active vehicle journey sections' is activated in the search parameters after running a PuT shortest path search. **(16694)**

### Graphics

- ✓ Display error in the line course layer: When drawing the line course layer under certain circumstances errors occurred (unnecessary loops of bars). This error has been fixed. **(15372)**
- ✓ Link stop points in the line course layer: It two directed link stop points were located on opposite relative positions, i.e. one at position x of the link and the other one at position 1-x on the link in the reverse direction, outliners in the graphic display existed. - ✔ Deleting marked objects within procedures: Visum no longer crashes when deleting marked network objects while a procedure is running, e.g. via COM. **(16661)**

- ✔ Search when editing: The program does not crash anymore when opening the search dialog (from a list or within the timetable editor) and a list cell is being edited. **(16565)**
- ✔ Shift vehicle journey to another line route: The program does not crash anymore when a vehicle journey is shifted to another line route and when this action is reversed using undo and subsequently redo is applied. **(16540)**

- ✔ Evaluation of flow bundle with an active OD pair filter: An existing flow bundle calculation with an active OD pair filter was repeated at every second change of the filter despite the fact that the option 'Filter network volumes' was deactivated. This error has been fixed. **(15853)**
- ✔ Graphics tools and search window: The program does not crash anymore when using one of the graphics tools (e.g. flow bundle, shortest path search, Isochrones) and the search window is open. **(15844)**

## I/O Interfaces

- ✔ Empty strings: In formulas the string literal of empty strings, i.e. the quotation mark, was not recognized correctly. This error has been fixed. **(15574)**

## Formulas, Lists

- ✔ Filter in the matrix list when changing language: In the matrix list a filter can be defined as formula. Attributes are entered and displayed in the current language. If the list layout is saved either by saving the layout file or by saving the version file with an open matrix list and then opened using a Visum with a different language the attributes were not translated. Consequently, the formula of the filter was invalid and matrices were not shown in the list. This error has been fixed. **(15583)**

## Graphics

- ✔ Calculation of lengths for print areas in networks with projections: When calculating the print area the network scale is used for several functions, e.g. for 'To maximum scale'. In networks with a projection so far the scale of the print area could not be calculated correctly. This error has been fixed. For projections that depend on a position or for projections with different scales in x- and y-direction an averaged scale is used for the calculation as it is done for other calculations. **(13017)**
- ✔ Graphic layer 'Route course': The program does not crash anymore when drawing the graphic layer 'Route course' and the line routes pass U-turns multiple times. **(15495)**
- ✔ Graphical scale in legend and numerical output of scale in the print frame: If a projection is used the graphical scale in the legend of the printout or in an output of the screenshot function was wrong. The same is the case for the numerical output of the scale in the print frame. This error has been fixed. **(15466)**

## I/O Interfaces

- ✔ Comment lines in the data area during VDV452-Import: So far the VDV452 import was canceled if for a table the number of imported data records did not correspond to the registered number with the end marker 'end:xxxx'. This could happen if comment lines were part of the data area which were counted as data rows from the source program. Now in this case a warning is issued, but the import continues. **(15545)**
- ✔ Empty trips to and from the depot in the VDV452 export: So far empty trips to and from the depot were not exported correctly. If a block starts with an empty trip to or from the depot, respectively, these trips are now exported as empty trips to or from the depot. **(15563)**
- ✔ Import 'PuT supply from Visum...' with stop points on links: Line routes could not be imported if they were using several stop points on the same link in the wrong order. This could happen if in the target network long links exist and stop points were located by dropping a perpendicular in a different order. This error has been fixed. **(15536)**
- ✔ Penalties during import of 'PuT supply from Visum...': When importing PuT supply from Visum candidates were not always evaluated with the correct penalty term if a new stop point needed to be created. As a consequence such candidates were preferred by mistake. This error has been fixed. **(15589)**



## Junction Editor

- ✔ Allocation of signal groups to lane turns: If a signal group has been allocated to a lane turn and other changes for the node were made and both the allocation and other changes were reversed later and user-defined attributes exist for lane turns the version file saved afterwards could not be opened anymore. This error has been fixed. **(15607)**
- ✔ Long reaction time for display of nodes: In networks with many nodes that are modelled in detail the display of the junction geometry in the junction editor took some time. This error has been fixed. **(15637)**

## Lists

- ✔ Lists 'PrT paths on link level' and 'Stop areas': The program does not crash anymore when a stop area is created, PrT paths exist and the list 'PrT paths on link level' is open. **(15551)**
- ✔ Printing when analysis rows are shown: If a list has been printed while analysis rows (sum, minimum, maximum, average) are shown the first row of the list contained wrong data. This error has been fixed. **(14500)**
- ✔ Save PrT path list as attribute file: The program does not crash anymore when a PrT path list is saved as .att file and several cores are used. **(15570)**

## Miscellaneous

- ✔ Import registry files: The automatic import of registry files at the start of Visum using an appropriate Config-file (VISUM.CFG) did not work anymore for the user settings, i.e. the user settings from the registry were not used when starting a new Visum. This error has been fixed. **(15654)**

## Network Editor

- ✔ Delete last zone: The program does not crash anymore if the zone with the highest number is deleted and the zone has several connectors with percentages defined for PrT. **(15605)**
- ✔ Delete node from main node: If a two-leg node of a main node was deleted using Multi-delete with the option 'Connect links' the data model of the junction geometry could be damaged with the consequence that the version file could not be saved anymore. This error has been fixed. **(15606)**
- ✔ Delete nodes with two legs and stop points: If the user preference 'Permit creation of link stop points' was not enabled and nodes with two legs and stop points were deleted the stop points were not deleted but converted to link stop points. This error has been fixed. **(15647)**
- ✔ Shift stop points on links: When shifting stop points on links the setting 'Permit creation of link stop points' under user preferences was ignored so far, i.e. it was also possible to move a stop point from a node to a link even if the corresponding check box was disabled. This is now no longer possible. **(15252)**


## PrT Assignment

- ✔ Assignment with ICA: The program no longer crashes if the network does not contain a node that is calculated using ICA or if MPA is used, and not all demand segments are assigned for which assignment results exist. In the latter case the execution of the assignment with ICA is still not possible and a warning is shown. **(15634)**

## PuT Assignment

- ✔ Check for temporary parallel vehicle journeys: The test for temporary parallel vehicle journeys within the timetable-based PuT assignment checked inactive vehicle journeys too even if only active vehicle journey sections were considered during assignment. This error has been fixed. **(15542)**
- ✔ Passenger trip chains between vehicle journeys after midnight: The PuT assignment failed if two vehicle journey sections of vehicle journeys that both operate after midnight are connected via a passenger trip chain and there exists a path that follows this passenger trip chain. - ✔ Instable results of line blocking with vehicle exchange: In rare cases it could happen that several calculations of line blocking with vehicle exchange using the same input data produced different solutions. Furthermore, vehicle combinations with smaller numbers were systematically preferred. Both errors have been fixed. **(15623)** 

## PuT Passenger Survey

- ✔ Stay on board on the survey vehicle journey: The transition from a survey path leg to a preceding or succeeding line can also include the option stay on board in the same vehicle journey. This however was only possible if the walk time within the stop was smaller than the dwell time of the vehicle journey at the stop point. This error has been fixed. To deal with such transitions within the PuT paths transitions which actually represent a stay on board are treated in the same way as passenger trip chains. More specifically, the transition between these path legs are not counted as a transfer. **(15600)**

## PuT Passenger Survey, Lists

- ✔ Reading survey data additively: If survey data were read additively and a PuT paths list was open this list did not show the correct number of PuT paths, but the newly added PuT paths only. It appears that the data was not read additively despite the fact that internally all PuT paths were present in the version. This error has been fixed. **(15635)**

## Scenario Management

- ✔ Long scenario indicators: The calculation of scenarios are not canceled anymore if scenario indicators consisting of long texts are created through 'Concatenate' or similar aggregation functions. **(15579)**

## Scenario Management, Procedure Sequence

- ✔ OSM license warning when calculating scenarios: When starting new Visum instances for the calculation of scenarios or for distributed computing of procedures so far a license warning appeared if in the default graphic parameters (std.gpa) the use of OpenStreetMap backgrounds was configured. This error has been fixed. **(15604)**

## Schematic Line Diagram

- ✔ Edge courses with high frequency: In the schematic line diagram edge courses for which the frequency (number of strokes) is set to greater than 1 are displayed by a single line if the zoom level does not allow the display of spacings between the lines for the current display resolution. So far the change between simple and more detailed display was by class. Now for all classes the same display is applied and this is done at a later stage. **(15569)**
- ✔ Preview of edge courses in the graphic parameter dialog: In the graphic parameter dialog of the schematic line diagram the preview of the classified display showed strokes despite the fact that in the schematic line diagram no edge course could be displayed due to an invalid attribute for the inner classification. This error has been fixed, i.e. in these cases the preview does not show edge courses. **(15559)**
- ✔ Prohibit boarding/alighting: The program does not crash anymore when for a time profile item boarding/alighting is enabled and vehicle journeys using this time profile item are displayed in the schematic line diagram and then the change is reversed, i.e. boarding/alighting is prohibited again. **(15560)**

## ❗ Breaking Changes

### PuT Line Blocking

- ❗ Instable results of line blocking with vehicle exchange: In rare cases it could happen that several calculations of line blocking with vehicle exchange using the same input data produced different solutions. - ✔ Lower limit of the 'Peak hour Factor': The lower limit of the attribute PHF ('Peak Hour Factor') in the ANM model has been lifted to 0.25 because of the fact that according the definition of the PHF smaller values do not make sense. If it was attempted to import an ANM file with smaller values than 0.25 into PTV Visum, an error message was shown but no reason for the failure has been given. This error has been fixed. **(15385)**

## Add-Ins

- ✔ General Transit Feed (GTF) import: When executing the Add-in 'Import General Transit Feed' now the direction definition of the network are used. So far the definitions for directions were created. **(15410)**
- ✔ Header lines in the GTF import: So far the GTF import failed if additional space characters existed in the header lines of the .csv files. This error has been fixed. **(15532)**

## COM

- ✔ Many attributes set via COM: If many attributes of network objects are changed using single COM commands (SetAttValue, write access to the Active property), the process has been unnecessarily slow if the property IVisum.StopDrawing is set. This error has been fixed. **(15471)**

## Data Model

- ✔ Attribute DSegSet of matrices: If only one matrix of matrix type 'demand' exists and if at least for one demand segment an assignment matrix is not selected then the matrix attribut 'DSegSet' has been filled with all codes of demand segments for which an assignment matrix was not selected. This error has been fixed. **(15521)**
- ✔ Walk times during the calculation of reached and missed transfers: So far when calculating missed and reached vehicle journey items (evaluation of the relation at the vehicle journey item and attributes 'Number of reached transfers' and 'Number of missed transfers' of a stop) walk times from the stop area of arrival to the stop area of departure were not considered if the two stop areas were identical, i.e. the value on the diagonal in the walk time matrix would be used. ## Dialogs

- ✔ Add-on modules in the license management dialog: In the license management dialog useless options appeared in additionally shown rows for add-on modules if the column width of column 'Use license' was changed. This error has been fixed. **(15425)**
- ✔ Buttons in the dialog 'Demand models': Many buttons in the dialog 'Demand models' refer to the selected object or objects, respectively, but the buttons were not grayed out if no objects were selected. This error has been fixed. **(14994)**
- ✔ Created objects in the dialog 'Demand models': After creating new objects in different Tabs of the dialog 'Demand models' the objects were not selected. This error has been fixed. **(15000)**
- ✔ Multi-editing and sorting order: The program does not crash anymore when entering the dialog Multi-edit for a network object type for which after sorting (classical, alphanumerical, hierarchical) the first attribute had subattributes. **(15514)**
- ✔ Shorten a line route with several time profiles: The program does not crash anymore if a line route with several time profiles is shortened in the dialog 'Edit line route'. **(15544)**
- ✔ Translation of 'Aktuelles Zeitintervall' ('current time interval'): The character string 'Aktuelles Zeitintervall' (current time interval) was not translated. This error has been fixed. **(15462)**
- ✔ Type warning for user-defined formula attributes: In the dialog 'Create/Edit user-defined attribute' a warning was shown when editing formula attributes and the type was not 'Number with decimal places'. This error has been fixed. **(15554)**

- ✔ OD pair filter with condition for PuT paths: The program does not crash anymore if the filter is switched on and off when a filtered PuT path list is open, the filter does not contain a condition for OD pairs but the number of conditions for PuT paths changes. **(15487)**

## Formulas, Visum Files

- ✔ Invalid formulas in version files: So far, reading version files was cancelled if formulas contained invalid characters. - ✔ Cancel Synchro import: If the Synchro import is cancelled directly after the start, some data were imported nevertheless before cancelling. This error has been fixed. **(15386)**
- ✔ Empty trips from line blocks in the VDV452 export: Depending from the Windows setting for 'Region and language' during the VDV452 export the length of empty trips from line blocks (table LINK, column LINK\_DISTANCE) was not always correct. This error has been fixed. **(15489)**
- ✔ Import 'PuT supply from Visum': If in the target network a new link is created with a new stop point at its end then this stop point has not been used by line routes imported later, but for each of these line routes a new stop point was created. This error has been fixed. **(14344)**
- ✔ Primary key during export to MS SQL server: The export to a SQL server database failed when additionally primary keys were created. This error has been fixed. **(15555)**
- ✔ Stop hierarchy for the VDV452 export: When exporting to VDV452 format so far the table STOP\_POINT was not exported following the conventions of the format. ## Junction Editor, Main Window

- ✔ Searching for nodes in the network with the junction editor open: The program does not crash anymore when searching for a node after a version file is opened in which the junction editor is open without showing a node and the synchronisation is active in both the search dialog and the junction editor. **(15459)**

## Line Blocking

- ✔ Open line blocks until after midnight: If open line blocks were created with vehicle journeys or empty journeys terminating after the line blocking time interval and partitions were created then the result of newly calculated partitions could depend on the previously created partitions but represented an equally good solution. This error has been fixed. **(15455)**
- ✔ Result message for procedure 'Line blocking': So far the result message for the procedure 'Line blocking' reported the number of line blocks of the last treated partition only. This error has been fixed. **(15494)**

## Main Window

- ✔ Second screen not available: Views or tool windows moved outside the main window on a second screen could not be reached if the second screen was not anymore available and a version file with such a window configuration was opened. This error has been fixed. **(15163)**

## PuT Passenger Survey

- ✔ Different parameters of shortest path search: The program does not crash anymore when survey data are checked during plausibilization and for both the survey path leg and prec./succeed. lines a connection search with different search parameters are used. **(15496)**

## Schematic Line Diagram

- ✔ Bundled edges when creating transfer nodes: When creating transfer nodes in the schematic line diagram bundled edges which touch the transfer node were falling apart if some of the corresponding vehicle journeys start or end at this new transfer node and others just pass through. This error has been fixed. **(15524)**

## 🚫 Breaking Changes

### PrT Assignment

- 🚫 Convergence criteria for assignment with ICA: For the evaluation of convergence criteria (ID 13537) only links for which a queue during assignment could be observed were considered. For the calculation of the GEH and the relative gap all links must be taken into account. This error has been fixed. Therefore, the number of iterations can change and consequently also the results of the assignment. **(15408 ✔)**

## + New Features and Changes

### Dialogs

- + Size of dialog for attribute selection: The size of the dialog for attribute selection (e.g. in lists) can now be made smaller than its initial size. This enables the usage of buttons when the screen resolution is low. **(15254)**

### I/O Interfaces

- + Access to MS Access data bases under 64bit: It is now possible to write data bases in the old format .mdb if a newer 64bit version of MS Access is installed on a machine. - ✓ Add-In 'Buffers around PuT Lines': The execution of the Add-In 'Buffers around PuT Lines' with the option 'Only stop points of active time profile items' could fail if a filter for time profiles was set and a projection was used in the network. This error has been fixed. **(15424)**

### Data Model

- ✓ Walk times between stop areas: If the number of a stop area was changed in a way that it influences the order of stop areas of one stop, then the walk times were wrongly swapped. The same happened if a new stop area with a smaller number as other stop areas of the same stop was added. This error has been fixed. **(15380)**

### Dialogs

- ✓ Create system routes for pairs of stop points: In the corresponding dialog it was sometimes possible that no transport system was selected. If the Ok button was pressed under these circumstances the program crashed. This error has been fixed. **(15407)**

- ✔ Frequent rebuild of lists using OD pair filter and flow bundle: The path list has been built up too often if an OD pair filter property is changed while both a flow bundle is calculated and an OD pair filter is active and a path list is open that makes use of either of these conditions as 'Selection'. **(15343)**

## Filters

- ✔ Evaluations of OD pair filter: The OD pair filter was evaluated too often if conditions in this filter were changed. If additionally a flow bundle is active, the corresponding calculation was also updated with each re-evaluation of the filter. This error has been fixed. **(7422)**

## Filters, Lists

- ✔ PuT path filter using Index: The program does not crash anymore when showing a filtered list and the OD pair filter for PuT paths is using the attribute 'Index'. **(15043)**

## Graphics

- ✔ Drawing during network changes: The program could crash if data of the network were changed while in the background calculations for drawing the network window have been executed. This error has been fixed. **(15439)**
- ✔ Drawing of route course layer: If the layer for drawing route courses is in the lower part of layers drawing was unnecessarily delayed. The error has been fixed. **(15397)**
- ✔ Under certain spatial circumstances for links the program could crash when drawing the corresponding bars. This error has been fixed. **(15470)**

## I/O Interfaces

- ✔ Cancel the ANM export: If the user were cancelling the ANM export during its first phase the ANM export did not respond. This error has been fixed. **(15382)**
- ✔ General Transit Feed (GTF) export: Only polygon points of links have been exported but not positions of nodes and stop points. Furthermore the coordinates were interchanged. This error has been fixed. **(15219)**

## Lists

- ✔ Split links: The program behavior has been improved. When splitting a link using an existing node a preview indicates which node is used. **(13729)**

## PrT Assignment, Junction Editor

- ✔ Distribution of volumes across lanes in the ICA calculation: When distributing volumes across lanes according to the HCM it is checked if the entire volume is distributed. This check resulted in an error message even for very small differences. If the distribution was calculated as part of the assignment with ICA, the assignment stopped due to the error message. The check now accepts deviations of very small magnitude. **(15435)**

## PuT Assignment

- ✓ Infinite Values in the 'Nested Demand Model': If infinite values (infinite large and small) occur during calculation, the procedure continued using '0'. This issue is solved. **(15298)**

- ✔ Set window section: When using the icon Set window section to enlarge the rectangle remained until the next drawing action. This error has been fixed. **(15189)**

## Timetable Editor

- ✔ Tabular time table: Visum no longer crashes when the regular services attributes are displayed in a layout grouped by service trip patterns. **(15208)**

## Visum Files

- ✔ Reading detectors from network and model transfer files: When reading network or model transfer files, the association of detectors to lanes at main nodes did not correctly account for the leg orientation of the cordon links. This was fixed. **(15286)**

## ❗ Breaking Changes

- + Signal offset optimisation: The procedure 'Signal offset optimization' is now also available in 64-Bit installations of PTV Visum. **(14935 🚫)**

## PuT Assignment

- + Assignment with MPA: The combination of the volumes after an assignment with MPA has been accelerated. **(15080)**
- + Capacity-restricted timetable-based assignment: The timetable-based assignment with capacity restriction has been accelerated. **(15145)**

## Scenario Management

- ⊕ Integrate project: The inverse operation to 'Export partial project' is now available in scenario management. Components of another project can be integrated into the currently loaded project. Of course, this only works if the projects share at least some common features, e.g.. Using both, the 'export partial project' and 'integrate project' jointly supports workflows for distributing project work to across several contributors or organisations. **(14987)**

## Timetable Editor

- ⊕ Improvements: The tabular timetable editor got some small improvements. The attributes at pass-through stops are shown in tooltips. Attribute values are generally centered. The selection in the vehicle journey items is synchronized with the global stop point selection. Settings for service trip patterns in the regular services mode can be altered directly from the grid. **(15177)**
- ⊕ Repeatedly traversed stops, Opening from search windows: If a stop of a line route is traversed repeatedly and the respective line route items are allocated to the same item of the stop sequence, in the tabular timetable, this is indicated by appending '...' to the output. The tooltip displays the attribute values of all traversings. ### Dialogs

- ✓ Edit POI-Categories: The Undo-function did not work properly after adding, editing or deleting POI categories. The command history was reset without warning, and in some situations Visum crashed. A messagebox now warns about the reset of the command history when adding or deleting POI categories (this can be switched off) **(15065)**
- ✓ railML-Export: Visum no longer crashes when the attribute selection in the dialog 'Export to railML' is changed after the dialog was already opened before for another network loaded in the same Visum session. **(15155)**

### Formulas

- ✔ Comparison patterns and export of partial projects: When exporting project parts to a partial project, list layouts stored in a comparison pattern were not exported. This bug was fixed. **(15196)**

## + New Features and Changes

### Formulas

- ✔ Chinese demo version: The demo version of PTV Visum ran in an infinite loop if it was started in Chinese. This error has been fixed. **(15052)**

## Network Editor

- ✔ 'Edit category' for POIs: If the Multi-edit special function 'Edit category' for POIs was called for all (active) POIs via the shortcut menu in the tool window 'Network', it had no effect so far. This error has been fixed. **(15067)**
- ✔ Deleting nodes, connecting links: When deleting a node with two legs and connecting the two adjacent links, the data of the same link was always used, regardless of the user's selection. This error has been fixed. **(15068)**

- + Coupling on vehicle journey level: Couplings represent portions of multiple vehicle journeys (of rail vehicles) conducted in common, which is done e.g. to provide higher capacities on the central trunk of a line, while separating into different breaches in the outer parts. Although the concept is usually applied to individual trips, the Visum data model covered this on the level of time profiles. If two trips are connected by a passenger trip chaining, the public transport assignment and skimming procedures will not count the connection as an interchange. The connection time is accordingly attributed to the riding time. The shortest path search, fare calculation, public transport indicators etc. have been adapted accordingly. Also, the importers for HAFAS and railML have been extended in order to cover passenger trip chains provided through these formats. **(4181)**
- + Share of bypass volume: The default value for the leg attribute "Share of bypass volume" has been changed to 1.0. **(14130 🚫)**
- + The calculation for overlapping time series items with time intervals has been improved. **(14703 🚫)**

## Demand Procedures

- + Modelling of Park+Ride: Two new procedures for modelling Park+Ride, namely P+R parking lot selection and P+R leg split, are available. The first procedure calculates for each relation possible P+R lots and distributes the Park+Ride demand. - + Tour-based freight model: This new addon module is specifically targeted to modelling commercial traffic. The special characteristics of commercial traffic are mainly brought into the model by a second procedure for freight trip generation. This procedures allows to model the common practice of grouping multiple services into a single tour of a vehicle in an aggregated, macroscopic manner. - + Tour-based model - Combined trip distribution/mode choice: The message for faulty (transformed) utility calculation has been improved. **(10264 🚫)**

- + Default value for walk times in stops: A default value for walk times within a stop can be defined in the user preferences. This value is being used when a stop area is added interactively or when a stop area is allocated to a different stop. **(12448 🚫)**
- + Entering dates: PTV Visum has now a modern, more convenient control to enter dates, which allows among other things copy & paste. **(13366)**

## PuT Assignment

- ❗ Branch&Bound-Search in timetable-based assignment: The concept of dominance among connections plays an important role in the connection search and thereby impacts the assignment result. The dominance was not consequently applied when special transfer times were defined for stops, resulting in dominated connections remaining part of the choice set. This behaviour was corrected. Assignment results may change slightly in networks containing these rather rare cases. **(14512)**
- ❗ Coordination in headway-based assignment: If lines are split into several coordinated lines with the same overall headway, the assignment result is now (almost) identical to the uncoordinated scenario. Remaining differences are due to (too) tight cutoff criteria only. **(14240 +)**
- ❗ Fare points on circle lines: Fare points on circle lines have not been considered correctly in the fare calculation. This error has been fixed. **(14791)**
- ❗ Farepoints for passing through: When using fare points for the impedance in the headway-based assignment the number of fare points for passing through was not correctly taken into account. This error has been fixed. **(10790)**
- ❗ Headway-based assignment with choice model "Optimal Strategies": The computation of route shares now works correctly even in the case that so many alternatives are considered that some of them are assigned a share below the path share threshold defined in the procedure parameters. Assignment results will change accordingly. **(14430)**
- ❗ Headway-based assignment: The procedure has been substantially improved by the systematic removal of pointless transfer options from the search graph. This particularly optimizes
  - \* the robustness of results when modifying network or parameters slightly,
  - \* the correctness of path choice in the case of multiple transfer options between a pair of line routes, and
  - \* computation time.This modification causes assignment results to change, particularly in the area of transfer flows. **(14510 +)**
- ❗ Preselection in timetable-based assignment: In the preselection step, the treatment of connections partially lying outside of the assignment interval was flawed under certain circumstances, and has been corrected in Visum 15. The error relates to the two preselection options for deleting connections departing before, or arriving after, the assignment period. The temporal comparison between the assignment period and the respective connection interval did not consider day changes correctly, and worked on absolute times instead. This could cause feasible connections to be deleted. The assignment result may change if any of the two affected preselection options is set. **(14306)**

## PuT Line Blocking

- ❗ Line blocking with vehicle interchange: The calculation has been accelerated significantly. Calculation results may differ slightly compared to earlier versions. **(14552 +)**

## Visum Files

- ❗ Procedure parameter files: When reading procedure parameter files in XML now empty attribute values are set. They are not anymore replaced by default values. **(14839 +)**
- ❗ Invalid control characters: Invalid control characters written to xml files could cause an abortion when reading these files. This error has been fixed. **(14847)**

## COM-API

- ❗ Some deprecated functions were finally removed:
  - Visum.Net.CalcPartNet --> use Visum.CalcSubNetwork instead
  - Visum.Net.GetNearestLink --> use Visum.Net.CeateMapMatcher().GetNearestLink instead
  - Visum.Net.GetNearestLinkCache --> use Visum.Net.CeateMapMatcher().GetNearestLink instead, Cache is automatically applied if the same MapMatcher-instance is used for successive calls
  - Visum.Net.GetNearestNode --> use Visum.Net.CeateMapMatcher().GetNearestNode instead
- IVehicleJourney.RemoveItems --> not required anymore **(13752)**

## Other Procedures

! MSA:

The procedures Method of successive averages (MSA) for attributes and Method of successive averages (MSA) for matrices were replaced by new functions in formulas. Therefore, the corresponding COM-class MSAPara and the access functions AttributeMSAParameters, ODMatrixMSAParameters and SkimMatrixMSAParameters at IOperation were removed. Scripts using these functions will no longer work and must be adopted. When reading legacy procedure parameters, MSA procedures are automatically converted into the equivalent formulas. (13986 [+](#))
